

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 5-91

OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE FOR THE CENTER CITY PLAN

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission released a long-range comprehensive plan in 1988 to guide the future growth and development of Center City into the twenty-first century; and

WHEREAS, The Plan for Center City has been well received by the business community as well as neighborhood organizations, professional associations and special interest groups; and

WHEREAS, the Plan has become a reference point for developers, community groups, and City officials as they confront issues and make policies and decisions regarding the future of Center City; and

WHEREAS, the Plan is a long-range plan whose implementation will require a high level of continuing cooperation between City government and the private sector over the next fifteen years;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, W. WILSON GOODE, Mayor of the City of Philadelphia, by the power vested in me by the Philadelphia Home Rule Charter, do hereby order as follows:

**SECTION 1. THE APPOINTMENT OF THE MAYOR'S CENTER CITY
PLAN OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE**

An Oversight Committee is hereby established for the purpose of monitoring and facilitating progress toward achieving the objectives of The Plan for Center City.

SECTION 2. ORGANIZATION

The Mayor's Oversight Committee will consist of six individuals who have a record of leadership in either the public or the private sector. The majority of these individuals shall be currently employed in the private sector, with the public sector represented by at least one member currently employed by City government. The Committee shall be staffed by the members of the City Planning Commission staff.

SECTION 3. RESPONSIBILITIES

The Oversight Committee will monitor progress toward achieving the objectives of The Plan for Center City. As part of this monitoring process, the Committee will prepare periodic written reports for the Mayor, assessing progress toward Plan recommendations. These reports will also be made available to the public. From time to time, the Committee will convene meetings of Center City stakeholders in order to assess progress toward realization of the Plan, to plan implementation strategies, and to build support for these initiatives. The Committee will arrange any other meetings, discussions, or reports necessary to facilitate implementation of The Plan for Center City.
