Fire Safety Representative

The Philadelphia Fire Department is looking for volunteers to be a "Fire Safety Representative" (FSR) on their block. The focus of this Life-Saving Program is for the FSR to provide a vital link between the Philadelphia Fire Department and your neighborhood. A FSR would receive e-mails from the Philadelphia Fire Department concerning any Fire Safety issues in their immediate area. The FSR is encouraged to e-mail the Fire Department concerning any fire related questions or if anyone on the block is in need of smoke alarms.

Requirements:

- Must reside in the City of Philadelphia.
- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Must have access to an e-mail account. If you do not have a computer, don't be discouraged, your local library provides free e-mail access. Or, feel free to get a family member, friend or neighbor involved by asking if they would mind receiving your e-mails to print out for you.
