MANAGING DIRECTOR'S ORDER NO. 5

TRANSFER OF THE FUNCTION OF MAINTAINING REGISTRY RECORDS  
FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF STREETS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF RECORDS

In order to promote efficient administration and to eliminate duplication, the function of maintaining registry records is transferred from the Department of Streets to the Department of Records.

The provisions of this Order shall become effective October 1, 1956.

The transfer is made in accordance with the Administrative Board's direction to effectuate the efficiency of the organization and administration thereof, and the better coordination of the activities of departments, boards and commissions as stated in Section 4-300 (4) and Section 3-700 of the Philadelphia Home Rule Charter.
