
MANAGING DIRECTOR'S ORDER NO. 66

ABOLITION OF PHILADELPHIA CIVIL DEFENSE COUNCIL  
AND TRANSFER OF CIVIL DEFENSE FUNCTION TO  
FIRE DEPARTMENT

In order to promote more efficient administration, the responsibility for emergency preparedness of the City of Philadelphia is transferred from the Philadelphia Civil Defense Council to the Fire Department.

The provisions of this Order are effective February 14, 1972.

This transfer is made in accordance with the Administrative Board's direction to effectuate the efficiency of the activities of departments, boards and commissions as stated in Section 4-300 (4) of the Philadelphia Home Rule Charter.
