What is a CSA?

CSA stands for "Community Supported Agriculture." A CSA is a relationship between the farmer and the consumer in which the consumer pays a fee upfront in exchange for a weekly supply of fresh produce throughout the growing season. CSAs allow people to know where their food comes from, along with supporting local, sustainable agriculture.



CSA members will receive:

22 weeks of fresh produce from June-October Large Share = 9-10 items/week - \$635 Medium Share = 5-6 items/week - \$370 EARLY BIRD SPECIAL: Sign up before April 1 and receive \$20 off!

A Typical Large Share May Include:

2lbs of tomatoes
1 bag of arugula
2lbs of zucchini
1 bunch of kale
1 bunch of radishes

2lbs of eggplant
1 bunch of swiss chard
1 bunch of collard greens
1 bunch of onions
2lbs of sweet potatoes

Flower Share = 1 bouquet/week (w/ off weeks) - \$140
