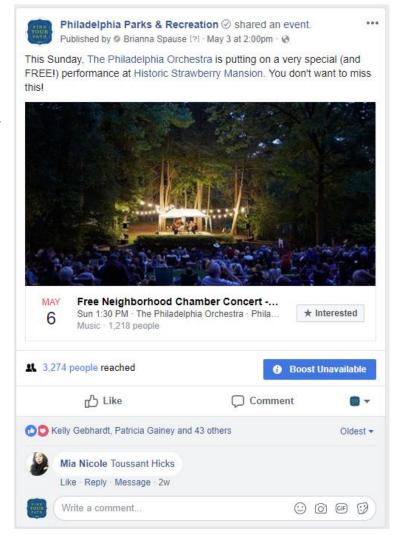
## **Top Social Media Report: May 2018**

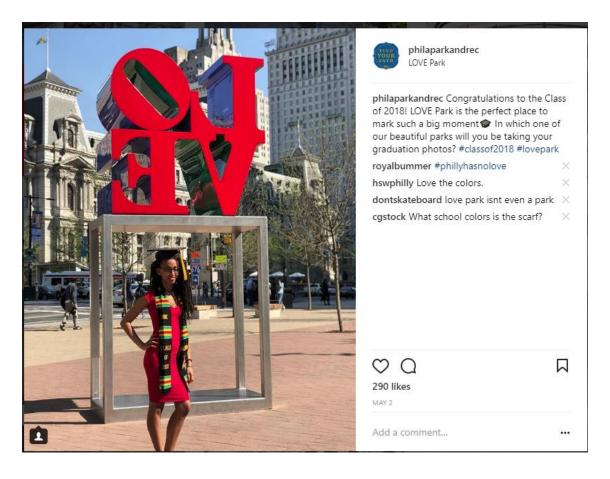
## **Top Facebook Post:**
