RSIs will be responsible for running multiple programs in collaboration with PPR staff at various rec centers and playgrounds city-wide.

Workforce RSIs will earn \$10.88 to \$15 per hour (depending on qualifications) while interacting with children, teens and adults all throughout our great city – Schedule will be 20-35 hours per week, including nights and Saturdays – Flexibility is strongly desired for this position.

- High School Diploma/GED – Post-secondary education is preferred.
- At least two years of experience working with youth and/or adults in varied field
- Current Child Abuse, Criminal Record and FBI clearances a plus
