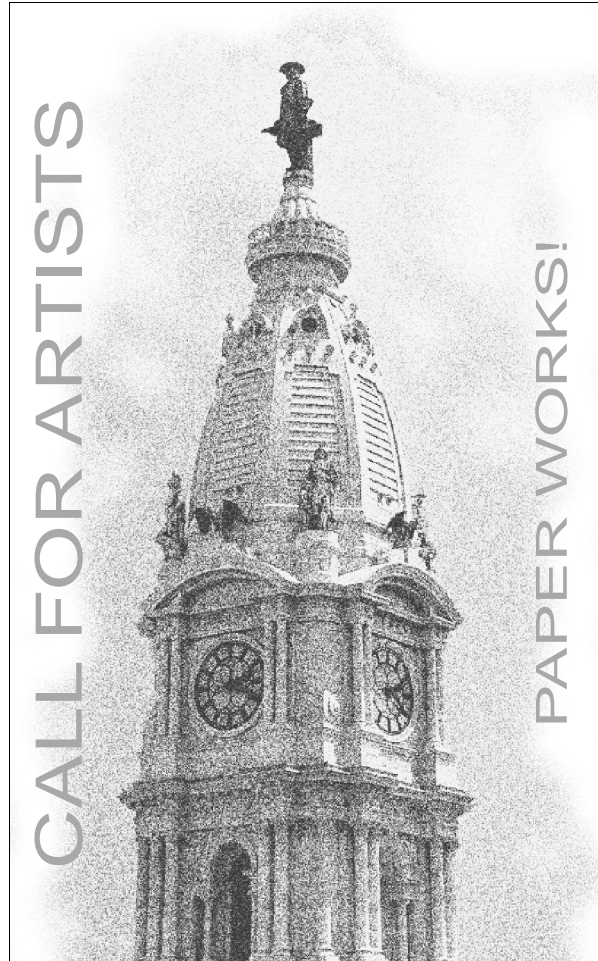


ART IN CITY HALL

AUGUST 14, 2009

Art In City Hall issues a call to Philadelphia area artists for the spring exhibition in the historic public corridors of City Hall.

Juror: Winifred A. Lutz, local artist and formerly Laura H. Carnell Professor of Sculpture at Tyler School of Art Temple University. (visit: www.phila.gov/artincityhall)

Theme: "PAPER WORKS!" is a celebration of works that utilizes paper as a medium, including: art books, paper sculpture, papier-mâché sculpture, assemblages, collages, constructions and installations; not just works on paper. The content/concepts behind the works are up to the artists.

Media

Open to all artists in all media. Artwork must comply with the dimensions of the display cases, which are 84" H x 94" W x 24"D.

Rules for Entry

- Deadline for submission: Received by Friday, August 14, 2009. You can submit up to four images in the form of digitals. No entry fee.
- Please submit jpegs on a CD. Each image should be no larger than 1MB, 72 dpi. Please call or email if you have questions. Each digital must have Last name, title, medium and dimensions as part of the "name" of the jpeg.
- Each submission must include a brief artist statement (no longer than two paragraphs) and resume as Word documents.
- Return the completed entry form with your digital submission and include a S.A.S.E ONLY if you wish to have your disc returned to you.

Eligibility & Selection of Artists

Open to emerging and professional artists living or working in the Philadelphia area, including graduate students. Artists will be selected by an independent panel of arts professionals.

Selection and Installation of Exhibition

Accepted artists will be notified by phone or email no later than two weeks before opening. Due to the volume of participants, if you are not notified two weeks before the show, your work was then not accepted. You can call to verify submission status. All work must be ready for installation (i.e., hooks, wires, etc). Artists are responsible for assisting with installation of works which require special attention or extensive demands of time.

The city and/or curators reserve the right to change the content of the exhibition, including the removal of artwork.

Delivery and Return of Work

The time of delivery and installation of artwork will be arranged with each participating artist after notification of acceptance. Artists or artists' galleries are responsible for shipping and delivery of works, including transfer insurance if needed. Please do not submit work that have already been sold or are out of the Philadelphia region.

Sale of Work

Art may be for sale, Art in City Hall does not take commission. Sales are between artist and interested party.

Liability

Artwork will be insured once installed in the display cases in City Hall.
