**The following are the titles of
Bills introduced in City Council
on January 25, 2005**

Bill No. 050001: “An Ordinance to adopt a Capital Program for the six Fiscal Years 2006-2011 inclusive.”

Bill No. 050002: “An Ordinance to adopt a Fiscal 2006 Capital Budget.”

Bill No. 050003: “An Ordinance adopting the Operating Budget for Fiscal Year 2006.”

Bill No. 050004: “An Ordinance amending Section 19-1801 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled ‘Authorization of Tax,’ to further authorize the Board of Education of the School District of Philadelphia to impose a tax on real estate within the City of Philadelphia; all under certain terms and conditions.”

Bill No. 050005: “An Ordinance amending Chapter 19-1800 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled ‘School Tax Authorization,’ by amending Section 19-1804, entitled ‘Authorization of Net Income Tax,’ to further authorize the Board of Education of the School District of Philadelphia to impose a tax on net income from real property and tangible and intangible personal property of residents of the School District of

Philadelphia; all under certain terms and conditions.”

Bill No. 050006: “An Ordinance amending Chapter 19-1800 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled ‘School Tax Authorization,’ by amending Section 19-1806, entitled ‘Authorization of Realty Use and Occupancy Tax,’ to further authorize the Board of Education of the School District of Philadelphia to impose a tax on the use or occupancy of real estate within the School District of Philadelphia.”

Bill No. 050007: “An Ordinance amending Chapter 19-1200 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled ‘Parking Tax,’ by establishing a rate of taxation on parking transactions for Fiscal Year 2006 and thereafter and making such rate contingent on certain decreases in business privilege tax rates.”

Bill No. 050008: “An Ordinance amending Section 19-2604 of The Philadelphia Code, relating to tax rates, credits and alternative tax computation for the business privilege tax, by reducing certain tax rates and making such reductions contingent on an increase in the parking tax.”

Bill No. 050009: “An Ordinance authorizing transfers in appropriations for Fiscal Year 2005 within the Grants Revenue Fund from the Director of Finance – Provision for Other Grants to the Mayor’s Office of Information Services, the Department of Licenses and Inspections, the Board of Trustees of the Free Library of Philadelphia, the District Attorney, the Register of Wills, and the City Commissioners.”

Bill No. 050010: “An Ordinance authorizing transfers in appropriations for Fiscal Year 2005 from the General Fund, certain or all City offices, departments, boards and commissions and from the Grants Revenue Fund, the Director of Finance – Provision for Other Grants to the General Fund, certain or all City offices, departments, boards and commissions.”

Bill No. 050011: “An Ordinance authorizing transfers in appropriations for Fiscal Year 2005 from the Grants Revenue Fund, the Director of Finance – Provision for Other Grants to the Special Gasoline Tax Fund, the Department of Streets.”

Bill No. 050012: “An Ordinance authorizing transfers in appropriations for Fiscal Year 2005 within the Water Fund from certain or all City offices, departments, boards and commissions to certain or all City offices, departments, boards and commissions.”

Bill No. 050013: “An Ordinance amending Section 2 of an Ordinance (Bill No. 010713) approved April 17, 2002, entitled ‘An Ordinance authorizing the revision of lines and grades on a portion of City Plan No. 194 by striking from the City Plan and vacating Bodine Street from Diamond Street to Susquehanna Avenue, under certain terms and conditions,’ by extending the time for compliance with the conditions stated therein.”

Bill No. 050014: “An Ordinance amending Chapter 20-1000 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled ‘Campaign Contributions and Expenditures,’ by requiring candidates for elective City office, treasurers of political committees and other persons to file certain campaign finance reports with the Board of Ethics, by requiring the Board of Ethics to arrange for the publication of such information on the City’s official website in a searchable format, and by making conforming changes to existing provisions of Chapter 20-1000, all under certain terms and conditions.”

Bill No. 050015: “An Ordinance authorizing transfers in appropriations for Fiscal Year 2005 within the General Fund from certain or all City offices, departments, boards and commissions to certain or all City offices, departments, boards and commissions.”

Bill No. 050016: “An Ordinance amending Chapter 19-1400 of The Philadelphia Code, entitled ‘Realty Transfer Tax,’ by excluding from the tax certain sub-subleases of property by the Fairmount Park Historic Preservation Trust, Inc. (‘Trust’) pursuant to a Master Sublease Agreement between the Philadelphia Authority for Industrial Development (‘PAID’) and the Trust, and pursuant to a Master Lease Agreement between the City and PAID, all as authorized by Bill No. 505 (approved June 8, 1993), under certain terms and conditions.”

Bill No. 050017: “An Ordinance granting permission to Bharat Patel, owner of the newsstand at the southwest corner of Broad Street and Arch Street, to construct, use and maintain an electrical conduit with an electrical service line and a telecommunications conduit with a telephone service line in and under the public rights-of-way for the purpose of supplying electrical service and telephone service to the newsstand, under certain terms and conditions.”
