## Favorable Ruling Won for Patient in Anti-Discrimination Lawsuit



Thousands walk in AIDS Walk Philly to support HIV/AIDS services in the Delaware Valley

The support of the Philadelphia City Employees' Combined Campaign allows AIDS FUND to provide unrestricted grants to local AIDS service providers that can be used for a wide-range of necessities not covered by government funding. Recently, Ronda Goldfein, Executive Director of AIDS Law Project of Pennsylvania, required transportation to Pittsburgh, PA to represent a woman living with HIV/AIDS in a discrimination suit. The client had no where else to turn, nor the resources needed to obtain adequate representation. As a result of an AIDS FUND grant, Ms. Goldfein was able to represent the client in person before the judge. The judge found that discrimination had occurred and granted a favorable ruling. Unfortunately HIV/AIDS discrimination continues to exist in our society, so the support of individual donors is critical to ensuring that people living with HIV/AIDS have access to services in their time of need.

In addition to the AIDS Law Project, AIDS FUND supports 30 other organizations providing a full continuum of HIV/AIDS prevention and care services in the region.
