JAMES FALLON AND TIMOTHY CARRE PLEAD GUILTY TO THREE CHARGES

November 14, 2003---Former 15th District Police Officers James Fallon, DOB 5-31-70, and Timothy Carre, DOB 1-18-74, pleaded guilty today before Common Pleas Court Judge Albert Snite to Indecent Assault, Simple Assault and Official Oppression in conjunction with a 12-11-02 attack of a woman in a police car at I-95 and Aramingo. All three charges are misdemeanors of the second degree, which means that the officers are not to re-apply for their jobs.

“This is a good result in light of the difficulties with this case,” said Assistant District Attorney Christopher Mallios. “Their guilty pleas ensure that they will not get their jobs back, and they hold the officers accountable for their actions. This begins the healing process for the victim.”

Each officer was immediately sentenced to four years reporting probation. They will be evaluated by the probation department and will be required to comply with the recommendations of the probation department.
