

*District Attorney's Detectives Arrest Juvenile Escapee in Philadelphia*

August 22, 2003----District Attorney Lynne M. Abraham today announced the arrest of a 17-year-old juvenile, one of three juveniles who escaped earlier this week from St. Gabriel's Hall in Montgomery County.

“We are grateful to those who provided the information necessary to take this juvenile back into custody,” said the district attorney. I also want to commend all of the officers for their excellent work.”

Detectives from the district attorney's juvenile warrant unit arrested the male juvenile without incident at approximately 8 a.m. today inside a house in the 3300-block of Mascher St., a few blocks from his home. The juvenile was transported to 1801 Vine St., where Montgomery County authorities picked him up and took him to Montgomery County for processing.

Tips and information from various sources led to the arrest. Officers assigned to 1801 Vine St. from the Philadelphia Police Department and the Philadelphia Sheriff's Department also assisted the district attorney's detectives in today's arrest.

Because of the age of the male, no information about his original crime will be released.
