150 turkeys and all the trimmings to support District Attorney Lynne Abraham's
12th annual Thanksgiving Food Drive.**

**In addition to the 150 turkeys, Acme Markets and Urban Genesis are providing
all the trimmings: pumpkin pies, brown-and-serve rolls, corn, green beans, yams,
potatoes, applesauce, spaghetti sauce, gravy, cranberry sauce, macaroni and pasta,
and of course stuffing. The food will arrive in two large ACME trucks outside the**

D.A.'s Office at approximately 11am, as will the 50 turkeys provided by The Capital Grille. The turkeys and trimmings will be assembled in the lobby of the District Attorney's Office, and neighborhood organizations will pick up the dinners at a later time and deliver them to families in their neighborhoods.

Judy Spires, President of Acme Markets, said Acme is donating the turkeys to the D.A. for the sixth consecutive year because Acme supports Lynne Abraham's Urban Genesis 501(c3) Foundation, and the company has the ability to contribute to the community.
