November 20, 2007----ACME Markets, The Capital Grille Restaurant and The Rittenhouse Hotel will combine to contribute 250 turkeys in support of District Attorney Lynne Abraham's 13th Annual Thanksgiving Food Drive.

In addition to the turkeys, ACME Markets and Urban Genesis are providing all the trimmings: pumpkin pies, brown-and-serve rolls, corn, green beans, yams,

potatoes, applesauce, gravy, cranberry sauce, macaroni and pasta, and of course stuffing. The food will arrive in two large ACME trucks outside the District Attorney's Office between 9am and 11am, as will the turkeys provided by The Capital Grille. The turkeys and trimmings will be assembled in the lobby of the District Attorney's Office, and neighborhood organizations will pick up the dinners at a later time and deliver them to families in their neighborhoods.

Judy Spires, President of ACME Markets, said ACME is donating the turkeys to the District Attorney for the seventh consecutive year because ACME supports Lynne Abraham's Urban Genesis 501(c3) Foundation, and the company has the ability to contribute to the community.
