PHILADELPHIA – The Philadelphia Board of Ethics is pleased to announce that on December 10, 2015, City Council approved the reappointment of Chair Michael H. Reed, Esq. to a five-year term on the Board. The confirmation of Chair Reed's reappointment by Mayor Michael A. Nutter was by a unanimous Council vote. His new five-year term expires on November 16, 2020. A copy of Resolution 150936 confirming Chair Reed's reappointment to the Board, which was introduced by Councilman Curtis Jones Jr. on behalf of Council President Darrell L. Clarke, is attached.

Chair Reed joined the Board on April 27, 2011 to fill the unexpired term of Sister Mary Scullion. That term expired on November 16, 2015, but the confirmation of his reappointment means that he will continue to serve on the Board. Chair Reed was voted Chair of the Board by his fellow Board members on December 19, 2012.

The Philadelphia Board of Ethics is a five-member independent board established by ordinance, approved by Philadelphia voters in May 2006, and installed on November 27, 2006. It is charged with providing ethics training for all City employees and enforcing City campaign finance, financial disclosure and conflict of interest laws. Pursuant to the Philadelphia Home Rule Charter, the Ethics Board has authority to render advice, investigate complaints and issue fines.
