

**AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO  
EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 6-88**

**NAME CHANGE OF  
OFFICE OF SERVICES TO HOMELESS AND ADULTS  
TO  
OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SHELTER AND SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, federal and state government budget and welfare proposals threaten to shred the social safety net; and

**WHEREAS**, an effective response to alleviating and preventing homelessness as a result of these cuts will require the efforts of several City departments, including Housing, Public Health, Human Services, and others; and

**WHEREAS**, the City needs to maintain emergency food, shelter, and other services for persons in immediate need of assistance;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Edward G. Rendell, by the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of Philadelphia, do hereby amend Executive Order No. 6-88 to change the name of the Office for Services to the Homeless and Adults to the Office of Emergency Shelter and Services. This office shall be headed by a Director who shall report to the Managing Director.

This order shall be effective immediately.

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 6-88

OFFICE OF SERVICES TO HOMELESS AND ADULTS

**WHEREAS**, the protection of citizens of the City of Philadelphia has always been of foremost importance; and

**WHEREAS**, eliminating homelessness and alleviating other conditions that threaten survival through the assurances of access to housing, jobs and other desired resources are of utmost importance; and

**WHEREAS**, providing leadership in long range planning and developing annually a comprehensive homeless assistance plan is necessary to achieve established objectives; and

**WHEREAS**, the Office of Services to Homeless and Adults must receive organizational status, both in recognition and importance.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, W. Wilson Goode, by the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of Philadelphia, do hereby establish the Office for Services to the Homeless and Adults. This office shall be headed by a Director who shall report to the Managing Director.
