There is a growing trend in the U.S. that schools, hospitals and workplaces are adopting outdoor smoke-free policies. Currently, at least 2,615 hospitals, 466 colleges and universities, and many large businesses in the U.S. have 100% tobacco-free campus policies. The goal of this conference is to bring together leaders from universities, hospitals and businesses to discuss, promote, encourage and help facilitate smoke-free campus policies in Philadelphia.
