

Notice – New Requirements for Sulfur Content in Commercial Fuel Oil AMENDED – On June 18, 2015, Mayor Michael Nutter signed City Council Bill No. 150500-A01 which amends City Council Bill No. 14510. In summary, Bill No. 150500-A01 allows the use until July 1, 2020 of any remaining No. 2 fuel oil stored at a facility prior to July 1, 2015. This extension may be extended to 2025 on a case by case basis. Facility owners are required to maintain records demonstrating all fuel delivered after July 1, 2015 complies with the new sulfur standard. The City Air Pollution Control Board will be promulgating regulations that outline the process for applying for such an extension in the near future. Notice – New Requirements for Sulfur Content in Commercial Fuel Oil – Effective July 1, 2015, all commercial No. 2 and No. 4 fuel oil sold, purchased, and burned in Philadelphia must be less than or equal to 0.0015% (15 ppm) sulfur and 0.2500% (2500 ppm) sulfur by weight respectively. See Phila. Code Sec. 3-207(1)(a) (1) (City Council Bill No. 14510, Approved July 15, 2014). Also effective July 1, 2015, all commercial No. 5, 6, and heavier fuel oil sold, purchased, and burned in Philadelphia must be less than or equal to 0.5000% sulfur (5000 ppm) by weight. Id. Users of commercial fuel oils are advised to discontinue purchasing fuel oil that does not meet these requirements.
