

DRY CLEANING REGULATION TIMELINE

On July 6, 2010, a public notice was published in three newspapers announcing the filing of proposed Air Management Regulation XIV - Control of Perchloroethylene (Perc) from Dry Cleaning Facilities.

On July 9, 2010, a letter was sent to all Perc dry cleaners informing them of the proposed regulation and public notice.

All comments or requests **MUST** be received by August 1, 2010.

When Records receives the comments or requests, they will forward them to the Philadelphia Department of Public Health, Air Management Services (AMS).

If there are no comments received or requests for a hearing, this regulation will become effective midnight, August 2, 2010.

If a hearing is requested, it will be held on Thursday, August 12, 2010, at 6 PM at the Spelman Building, 321 University Avenue, 1st Floor Conference Room, Philadelphia, PA 19104.

At the hearing, comments are read and recorded by a stenographer; it is not interactive.

All submitted comments and comments made at the hearing will be addressed by AMS.

A comment/response document will be posted on the AMS web site at <http://www.phila.gov/health/AirManagement/index.html>.

A comment / response document and the proposed regulation will be reviewed and voted on by the Philadelphia Air Pollution Control Board at the next meeting scheduled on November 17, 2010 @ 2 PM @ the 500 South Broad Street Building in Philadelphia in the 1st Floor Auditorium.

If approved, a report will be filed with the Philadelphia Department of Records.

The regulation will then become effective at midnight of the tenth day after the report has been filed when a hearing was requested and held.
