AMENDMENT TO REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE CONTROL OF
COMMUNICABLE AND NON-COMMUNICABLE DISEASES AND CONDITIONS

WHEREAS, Section 6-102 of the Health Code of Philadelphia authorizes the Board of Health to establish lists of communicable, reportable and quarantineable diseases; and

WHEREAS, Section 6-202 of the Code requires that physicians, osteopaths and veterinarians who treat those reportable diseases designated by the Board report the incidence of such diseases to the Department; and

WHEREAS, the Philadelphia Board of Health has adopted Regulations Governing the Control of Communicable and Non-communicable Diseases and Conditions; and

WHEREAS, said regulations contain a listing of such diseases and the method of reporting the incidences thereof in Sections 2 and 3 of said regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health finds that Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS) is a communicable disease which presents a public health problem;

The Board of Health, pursuant to its authority under Section 6-102 and 202 of the Health Code of Philadelphia, hereby designates Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome as a reportable disease; and thereby amends the Regulations Governing the Control of Communicable and Non-communicable Diseases and Conditions so as to include AIDS in the listing of diseases which must be reported to the Department in the manner prescribed therein.
