


SAFE Services

- Care coordination
- In-home parenting skills training
- Advice about breastfeeding and infant nutrition
- Referrals for community resources (food, clothes, furniture)
- Help making medical appointments for parents and children



- Help quitting smoking and getting treatment for drug and alcohol abuse
- Help getting health insurance and other benefits
- Tips to prevent injuries and avoid accidents (including car safety)
- Information about healthy child development, including immunizations (baby shots)

- Parenting workshops (baby care, healthy foods, temper tantrums, setting limits, childhood asthma, etc.)



- Baby items, parent/child activity books and other materials

Keeping Philadelphia Families SAFE

SAFE — Services to Assist Families to Excel — is a case management and home visiting program for Philadelphia families with children from birth to age five.

SAFE provides families with the information, resources and support they need to protect and nurture the health of their children.

Trained home visitors work closely with parents and other caregivers to help them make good choices for the health of their families.

All SAFE services are free. Services are based on the Partners in Parenting Education (PIPE) curriculum.
