Summary

The Office of Innovation & Technology (OIT) is the central IT agency for the City of Philadelphia, headed by the Chief Innovation Officer (CIO). The Licenses & Inspection IT unit has responsibility for supporting the critical applications used in the Department of Licenses and Inspections for Commercial Licensing, Inspections and Permit Services. The primary responsibility of this position is to help support the existing Production Hansen CDR applications while performing as a team member of the eCLIPSE Project that replaces the Hansen client/server applications with web-based modules.

The successful candidate must reside in the City of Philadelphia or establish primary residence in the City of Philadelphia within six months of employment. This position is open to US Citizens and those that are authorized to work in the US. Please provide citizenship status when applying for this position.

Responsibility

The primary responsibilities of the Software Developer assigned to the Department of Licenses & Inspections (L&I) working under the direction of the Programmer Analyst Supervisor, are the following:

- Participate as a team member of the eCLIPSE Project implementations using the web-based POSSE Land Management System (LMS) applications;
- Work closely with the project team members to develop quality documentation and test plans;
- Develop custom queries, scripts, macros, views and other methods for the current Hansen V7.7 Oracle 11g database to meet customer needs and Right-to-Know requests in a timely manner;
- Troubleshoot Oracle Reports and Forms (6i or higher) used by the Hansen V7.7 applications;
- Work well with Office of Innovation and Technology (OIT) resources and other departments on inter-departmental tasks and projects.
