

Executive Order No. 10-84
May 22, 1984

Directive Establishing the Office of Performance
Assessment of the City of Philadelphia

I, W. Wilson Goode, Mayor of the City of Philadelphia, with the authority vested in the Office of the Mayor by the Philadelphia Home Rule Charter, do hereby order the following:

1. Establishment. There is established in the Executive Office of the Mayor an Office of Performance Assessment of the City of Philadelphia to be headed by a Special Assistant who shall be appointed by and report to the Mayor.

2. Purpose. The purpose of this Office is to more effectively prevent or correct fraud, abuse, waste and mismanagement in the programs and operations of the government of the City of Philadelphia, and to effectuate the mandates of Section 4-106 of the Home Rule Charter to receive and investigate complaints concerning the operation of the City government.

3. Functions. The Special Assistant for Performance Assessment shall:

(a) Conduct and supervise management audits and investigations relating to programs and operations of the City of Philadelphia within the executive branch.

(b) Provide leadership and coordination and recommend policies for activities designed:

1. To promote economy, efficiency and effectiveness in the administration of, and

2. To prevent and detect fraud and abuse in such programs and operations; and

(c) Provide a means for keeping the head of each agency and the Mayor fully and currently informed about problems and deficiencies relating to the administration of such programs and operations and the necessity for and progress of corrective action.

4. Effective Date. This Order shall be effective immediately.
