### ARTIST REGISTRY

The Artist Registry invites artists to participate by maintaining a record of their work with the Philadelphia Public Art Program. Public art staff, panelists, architects, and City agencies will consult the Artist Registry as opportunities become available. The Artist Registry will be the primary means of selecting artists for public art projects. Some additional competitions may be announced. The Artist Registry is open to all professional artists. There are no residency requirements, although some opportunities will be limited the greater Philadelphia region.

### SUBMISSION INFORMATION

Mail one CD with six JPEGs of previous work, along with a corresponding image identification list, resume, 3 references, application form and an artist statement. Please label all materials.

*Checklist of materials:*

- ◇ Application form, signed & dated (hard copy)
- ◇ One CD with 6 JPEGs\*\*
- ◇ Image Identification List (title, date, materials, size and location if applicable)
- ◇ Resume including 3 references (references: name & contact info)
- ◇ Artist Statement (optional)

\*\*Images must be PC-compatible, saved as JPEGs at 72 dpi, no larger than 1000 pixels in any direction. **All images must be clearly labeled with the artist's last name, first name, and number.** Example: smith\_jane\_01. Do not embed images into a Power Point presentation. Collaborative teams may submit up to four digital images per artist. Please do not include catalogs, invitations, etc.
