Mt. Moriah Cemetery Clean Up: June - July 2011

In late June 2011, the Mayor's Office of Neighborhood Services answered the call to do something about the property neglect found at the historic Mt. Moriah cemetery located in Southwest Philadelphia. Crews from the Vacant Lot Program worked at the cemetery for several days and removed tons of short dumped trash, cleared hidden paths and headstones that were overgrown with weeds, cut down brush, trimmed trees and shrubs and even hauled away an abandoned vehicle found at the site.
