

**Extension Worksheet
BPT-NS/NS EZ
1998**

This is a worksheet only. Please use your extension coupon to request an extension.

This is an extension worksheet, to be used when figuring the amount of Business Privilege Tax you owe. To request an extension of time to file your tax return, you must file an extension coupon by the due date of the return. This coupon must be filed even if you have no tax due and you are requesting an extension of time to file. You must then file an actual return by the extension due date to satisfy your filing requirements.

An automatic extension of time for filing the 1998 Business Privilege Tax NS/NSEZ will be granted for 60 days by filing the extension coupon and paying 100% of the estimated tax due. If an extension of time to file has been obtained from the Internal Revenue Service for filing your corporate, partnership or individual tax returns, the corresponding Business Privilege Tax NS/NSEZ return is due on or before the due date of the federal extension(s) or 6/15/99, whichever is later.

1. Total Tax(100% of estimated tax due) 1.
2. Other payments and credits you expect to show on BPT NS/NSEZ 2.
3. Tax balance due (subtract line 2 from line 1). If line 2 is more than line 1 enter zero (0). Enter this amount on a Business Privilege Tax NS/NSEZ extension payment coupon 3.

Interest & Penalties - The form Business Privilege Tax - New Start extension coupon does not extend the time to pay the tax. Interest and penalty shall be added to the amount of tax not paid by the statutory due date.
