


Keep your water service flowing!



If you're behind on your bill, your water service may be shut off starting April 4th.

Ways to pay

Mail

Mail in the return portion of your bill with a check or money order made payable to:

By Bank Transfer

Call **215.686.6880** to learn how to authorize "Zip Check" and "Zip Phone" automatic payments from your bank account.

Online

Go to www.phila.gov/water and click "Pay Your Bill." You'll need your 16 digit water/sewer account number, email address, bank account number or a credit/debit card.
Note: the provider charges a service fee.

By Phone

Call **1.877.309.3709**. Be ready with your 16 digit water/sewer account number and a credit/debit card. *Note: the provider charges a service fee.*

Payment Agreements

Pay your balance over a 12-month period. Call **215.686.6880**.

Low Income Payment Agreements

Pay an adjusted monthly amount based on household income. Call **215.686.6880**.

Senior Citizen Discount

A 25% discount for those over 65 with household income of \$31,500 or less. Call **215.686.6880**.


Home Emergency Loan Program (HELP)

HELP is an interest-free, installment-payment program for up to five years. Homeowners are eligible for this program only if they receive a notice of defect for their water service and/or sewer lateral. Call **215.685.4901**.

UESF provides emergency financial assistance to help families pay their water bills.
