

How do I apply for an IA Stormwater Credit?

First, Determine if you have any existing stormwater management practices (SMPs) on your property. Then follow the steps listed below.

Yes! I have an existing SMP.

No, but I want one.

Was this SMP built to comply with the Philadelphia Stormwater Regulations (effective Jan 1, 2006)?

Contact an engineer, surveyor, architect, or landscape architect to help you prepare FORM B: Stormwater Credits Application.

Contact an engineer, surveyor or architect to evaluate the SMP to determine if it is eligible to receive credit.

If it is, then complete and submit FORM B: Stormwater Credits Application. An engineer, surveyor or architect must help you prepare the supporting documentation.

Select a consultant to design a SMP for your property or redesign an existing one.

Submit the design plans to PWD Plan Review as a Stormwater RETROFIT project. Visit www.phillyriverinfo.org for more information.

PWD will provide credits design guidance and assist you in obtaining any other permits that may be necessary.

After creating the final design, obtain any other necessary City/State permits and produce construction documents.

Select a contractor and construct the SMP.

Once the SMP is built, contact your design consultant to help you complete and submit FORM B: Stormwater Credits Application.
