

MANAGING DIRECTOR'S DIRECTIVE NO. 23


SERVICE CONNECTED INJURIES OR ILLNESS

This Directive supplements Procedural Instruction No. 13.

With regard to employees with service connected injuries or illnesses, when the employee is returned to active duty, after having been treated and the condition resolved, no follow up visits to the Compensation Clinic are to be permitted for that specific injury (i.e. returned to active duty on 3/6/83 and returning for same injury 4/11/83 to Compensation Clinic), unless they have been scheduled by the Compensation Clinic.

This, of course, does not apply to referrals for new injuries or illnesses.

When an employee complains of a recurrence of an old injury, employee is to contact supervisor. The department will set policy for judgement of such requests to return to the Compensation Clinic. If the department determines that the employee may return to the clinic for that injury or illness, proper referral procedures are to be followed.
