
MANAGING DIRECTOR'S ORDER NO. 61

TRANSFER OF BILLING AND ACCOUNTS  
MAINTENANCE FUNCTION FOR INPATIENT  
CARE FROM DEPARTMENT OF COLLECTIONS  
TO PHILADELPHIA GENERAL HOSPITAL


The responsibility for the billing and maintenance of accounts for inpatient care at the Philadelphia General Hospital is transferred from the Department of Collections to the Hospital to consolidate them with identical functions being performed by the Hospital for outpatient care. This transfer is designed to consolidate under single supervision and control the administration of these functions, thus promoting greater efficiency in operation.

The provisions of this Order shall become effective August 18, 1969.

This transfer is made in accordance with the Administrative Board's direction to effectuate the efficiency of the activities of departments, boards and commissions as stated in Section 4-300(4) of the Philadelphia Home Rule Charter.
