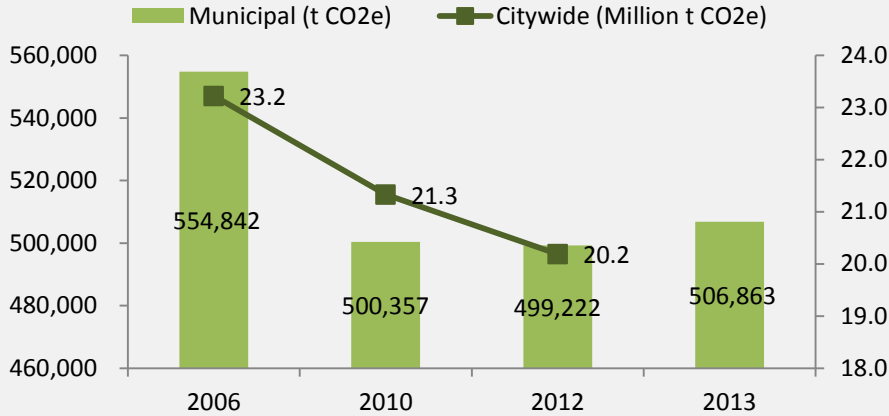


Goal 4: Establish Philadelphia as the Greenest City in America

Greenhouse Gas Emissions

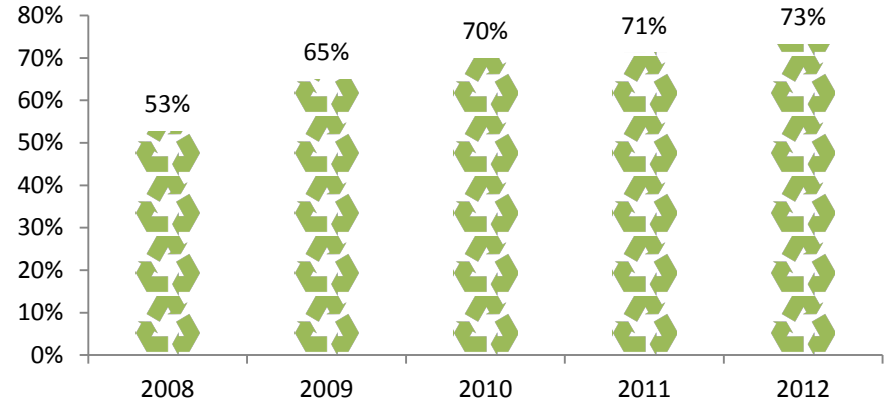
Citywide greenhouse gas emissions declined by 13% between 2006 and 2012 despite an increase in population and real estate development.

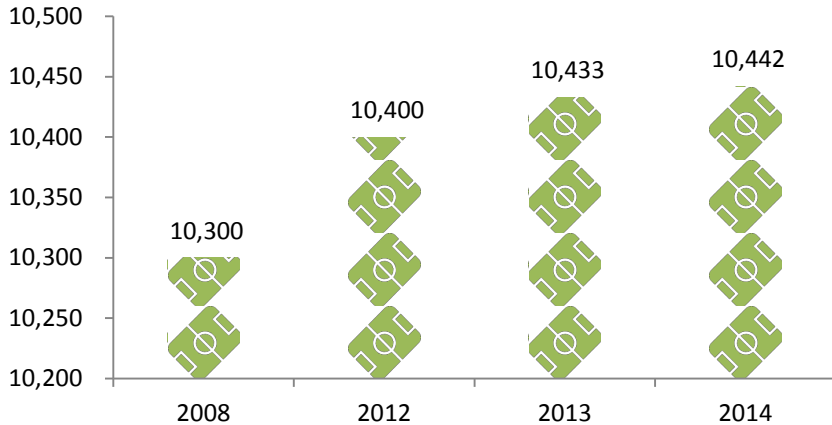
Waste Diversion

The City has exceeded its target of diverting 70% of waste from landfill, and, starting in 2014, now diverts all non-recyclables to waste-to-energy plants.



Acres of Open Space

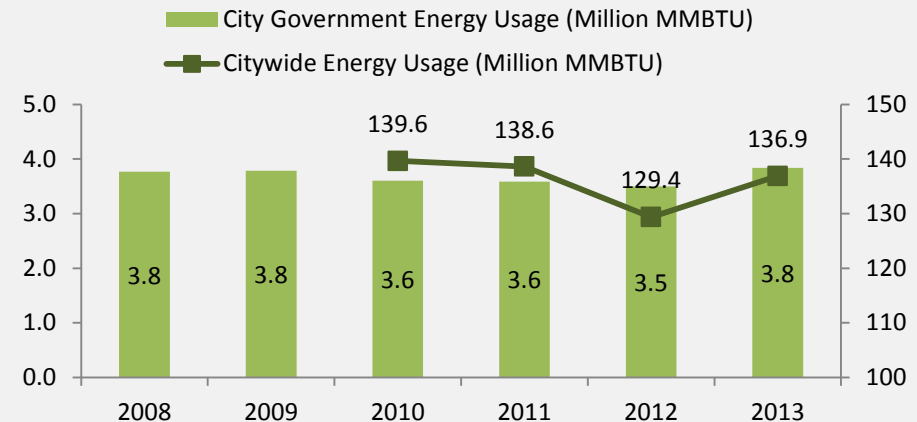
The City has added 107 football fields of open space since 2008, including 16 miles of trails.
