How do I use the search tool?

When you click on the link above, you should see a Google Custom Search box. Use the search box as you would a regular Google search. Type in words or phrases that you think may be relevant, and then click the button with the magnifying glass to search. You can find some advanced search tips here.

What can I search?

The Advisory Opinion Search includes all opinions issued by the Board or its General Counsel. It also includes some Advisory Alerts issued on topics of general interest. This search does not include <u>Board decisions in administrative adjudications</u>, <u>Board settlement agreements</u>, state or federal ethics opinions, or court decisions. More information about the process for requesting opinions from the Board is provided in <u>Board Regulation 4</u>.

How complete will my search results be?

Some older opinions may not have fully searchable text. While the Google-based search engine may be able to identify your search terms even in those opinions, we cannot guarantee that it will catch every appearance of a term. You may want to use the Advisory Opinions main page to check for any additional opinions that may be relevant to your topic.
