

## **SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**


Pursuant to section 4-1100 of the Philadelphia Home Rule Charter, the Board of Ethics is responsible for enforcing the Philadelphia's Campaign Finance Law, which is found at Chapter 20-1000 of the Philadelphia Code.

1. Friends of T. Milton Street Sr. for Mayor is the authorized candidate political committee of T. Milton Street Sr., a former candidate for Mayor in the May 2015 Philadelphia primary election.
2. Pursuant to the City's Campaign Finance Law, from May 5 through May 19, 2015, within 24 hours of accepting any contributions of \$500 or more, Friends of T. Milton Street Sr. for Mayor was required to electronically file a campaign finance report with the Board disclosing those contributions.
3. During the 24 hour reporting period, Friends of T. Milton Street Sr. for Mayor should have electronically filed three separate campaign finance reports with the Board, but failed to do so. On June 17, 2015, T. Milton Street Sr. contacted Board enforcement staff to self-report that his committee had failed to timely file these reports. On June 18, 2015, Friends of T. Milton Street Sr. for Mayor took prompt corrective action and electronically filed the required reports with the Board.
4. In addition to self-reporting the failure to file and taking prompt corrective action, Mr. Street and Friends of T. Milton Street Sr. for Mayor have fully cooperated with Board enforcement staff in the resolution of this matter.
5. Friends of T. Milton Street Sr. for Mayor's failure to electronically file 24 hour reports with the Board violated the City's Campaign Finance Law, for which Mr. Street will pay a civil monetary penalty of \$1,500. Payment shall be by check or money order made payable to the City of Philadelphia and delivered to the offices of the Board within 14 days of the effective date of the Agreement.
6. Mr. Street and Friends of T. Milton Street Sr. for Mayor release and hold harmless the Board and its staff from any potential claims, liabilities, and causes of action arising from the Board's investigation, enforcement, and settlement of the matters described in this Agreement.
7. In consideration of the above and in exchange for the compliance of Mr. Street and Friends of T. Milton Street Sr. for Mayor with all of the terms of the Agreement, the Board waives any further penalties or fines against them for the violations described in this Agreement.
8. If the Board or the City is forced to seek judicial enforcement of this Agreement, and prevails, Mr. Street and Friends of T. Milton Street Sr. for Mayor shall be liable for attorneys' fees and costs reasonably expended in enforcing compliance with the Agreement. Fees for time spent by Board or City attorneys shall be calculated based upon standard and customary billing rates in Philadelphia for attorneys with similar experience.

9. The Executive Director will submit a signed copy of the Agreement to the Board for approval. The Agreement shall become effective upon approval by the Board. The effective date of the Agreement shall be the date the Board Chair signs the Agreement.
10. If the Board rejects the proposed Agreement, presentation to and consideration of the Agreement by the Board shall not preclude the Board or its staff from participating in, considering, or resolving an administrative adjudication of the matters described in the Agreement. If the Board rejects the proposed Agreement, nothing in the proposed Agreement shall be considered an admission by either party and, except for this paragraph, nothing in the Agreement shall be effective.


