ARE THESE POLICIES DIFFERENT FOR THE PHILADELPHIA GAS
WORKS THAN THEY WOULD BE FOR THE PHILADELPHIA WATER
DEPARTMENT WITH RESPECT TO ARREARAGE FORGIVENESS?

RESPONSE:

The phrase "City policies" refers to City policies on the authority for arrearage forgiveness pursuant to the Philadelphia Home Rule Charter. The authority for arrearage forgiveness lies not with the Rate Board nor the Water or Revenue Departments, but with the Law Department. *See* Philadelphia Home Rule Charter §§ 1-102(1), 4-100, 6-201, 4-400(b), and 8-410. "Under the Charter, only the Law Department has authority to settle delinquent debts." *See* Memorandum to Bernie Brunwasser, Chairman, Water, Sewer, and Stormwater Rate Board from Sozi Pedro Tulante, City Solicitor, dated June 6, 2016, page 6, attached hereto. The Charter states:

Whenever any officer, department, board or commission shall require legal advice concerning his or its official business or whenever any legal question or dispute arises or litigation is commenced or to be commenced in which any officer, department, board or commission is officially concerned or whenever any taxes or other accounts of whatever kind due the City remain overdue and unpaid for a period of ninety days it shall be the duty of such officer, department, board or commission, to refer the same to the Law Department.

See Philadelphia Home Rule Charter §8-410 (emphasis added). The Philadelphia Water Department and the Department of Revenue are City departments; the Philadelphia Gas Works is not a City department, thus not subject to this provision of the Charter.
