segregated from the City of Philadelphia General Fund and is authorized solely to be used for hazmat-related expenditures (e.g. supplies, equipment, salary)

For certain special events, the Philadelphia Fire Department provides EMS or fire suppression presence. Under certain circumstances, the Philadelphia Fire Department will either invoice a group directly or invoice through the Managing Director's Office to recover costs related to the overtime required for the additional presence. All revenue in this category is deposited in the City of Philadelphia General Fund.

The Fire Marshal's Office charges fees for certain services such as providing expert witness testimony, expert consultation services, and document provision. Fees are based on the costs associated with the time and/or materials involved. All revenue in this category is deposited in the City of Philadelphia General Fund.
