
This summary is based on a merge between jail and court data from the baseline (July 30th, 2015) and present day (August 31st, 2018).




In 2016, Philadelphia was awarded \$3.5 million dollars as part of the MacArthur Foundation's Safety and Justice Challenge which is a national initiative to reduce local jail populations and the rate of racial, ethnic, and economic disparities in the criminal justice system.

Since then, Philadelphia has implemented a number of collaborative reform measures with justice and behavioral health partners to help achieve a target reduction of 34% in the city's jail population. This summary provides a high level look at progress to date and comparison of the current population to baseline data.


# Total Population

# Confinement Groups

## Pretrial No Detainers (Non-Murder)

Individuals who are confined pending their open case.

This includes individuals with active or revoked bail.

# Pretrial No Detainers (Murder)

Individuals charged with murder pending their open case.

Generally individuals in this group are denied bail.

### Detainers

Individuals with detainers, both Philadelphia and Non-Philadelphia, who have not been sentenced. Includes open cases and no open cases.

#### Sentenced

Individuals who have been sentenced with no detainers.

## Sentenced + Detainers

Individuals who have been sentenced and have a detainer of any kind.


### Other

Remaining individuals that could not be captured by previous groups.




This means that these individuals would need to post 10% of their monetary bail to be released from jail.

## Detainers



Detainers are various types of "holds" that can be keeping an individual in jail. Individuals in this group have detainers issued by Philadelphia and/or another jurisdiction.

## Sentenced



Individuals in this group are currently serving a sentence. They may have additional open cases in Philadelphia and/or other jurisdictions.
