4. Presentation on AMRXII Parking Garages by Ramesh Mahadevan (see attached)

Ramesh Mahadevan gave a presentation which reviewed the proposed amendment; which is a permitting *and* licensing requirement to the current regulation, AMR XII. His overview explained the new requirements for the 2 garage technologies: "open & enclosed". Mr. Mahadevan explained the goals and purpose of the amendment, provided definitions, and gave an update on the AMR regulation XII procedures and guidance document.

Questions:

Dr. Frank: Is an installation permit now required?

Ans. Yes it requires an installation Permit to force the facility to comply with the regulation

Dr. Frank: Is the regulation finalized?

Dr. Sellassie: Yes, it is finalized.

5. Presentation on Philadelphia Air Quality Study by Amy K Huff, Ph.D. PA State University Professor

Amy Huff gave a presentation by phone. No handouts were distributed.

Questions:

Mr. Tom Weir: How did you consider cloud cover? Has it changed recently?

Dr. Huff: That was precipitation, not necessarily cloud cover; the sun is needed for Ozone formation that's why when it rains there is less Ozone.

Mr. Mahadevan: How do you improve indoor air quality?
