SECTION 1. The following regulations are hereby rescinded.

- (a) "Regulations for Granting Waivers Relating to Neutering Under Title 10 of The Philadelphia Code Relating to Animals, Section 10-103(8)," transmitted to the Department of Records on July 18, 1990.
