

Inasmuch as there were no requests for hearings, these Regulations became effective midnight 12/2/13.







**Adoption of State Barber and Beauty Shop Laws and Regulations**

SECTION 1. Adoption.

(A) Any violation, by any person subject to § 6-402(3) of The Philadelphia Code, of the Act of June 19, 1931, P.L. 589, No. 202 (63 P.S. § 566 *et seq.*) (pertaining to Barbers), or the Act of May 3, 1933, P.L. 242, No. 86 (63 P.S. § 507 *et seq.*) (relating to Beauty Culture), or of any regulation under Chapters 3 or 7 of Title 49 of the Pennsylvania Code (regulations issued by the State Board of Barber Examiners and State Board of Cosmetology, respectively), shall be a violation of this Regulation.

(B) Any person who violates subsection (A) shall be subject to a fine of not less than one hundred fifty (150) dollars and not more than three hundred (300) dollars. Where the Department of Public Health finds that any continuing violation of subsection (A) constitutes a public nuisance pursuant to Code § 6-402(9), it may order abatement of such nuisance, and seek any remedy provided under Code § 6-103(5).

SECTION 2. Repeal. The regulation titled "Regulations Governing Operations and Conduct of Barber and Beauty Shops, and Schools and Colleges for the Training of Barbers and Beauty Culture Operators," submitted to the Department of Records on June 12, 1956, is hereby rescinded.

SECTION 1. Adoption.

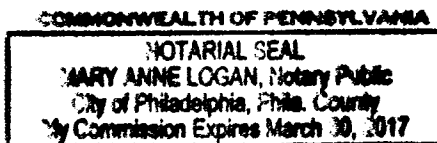

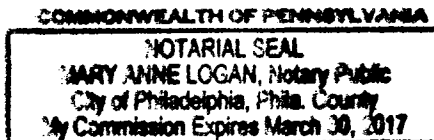

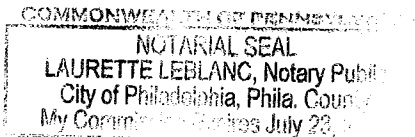
