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INTRODUCTION

This Report primarily focuses on vital events data for births and deaths occurring to Philadelphia residents in 2000, but also contains data on morbidity and population.

A separate publication contains selected birth and death data for health districts, neighborhoods and census tracts in Philadelphia, as well as morbidity data by health district.

The birth and death data is obtained from death certificates and computer files provided by the Pennsylvania Department of Health. They require that the following statement be included: "These data were supplied by the Division of Health Statistics, Pennsylvania Department of Health, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. The Pennsylvania Department of Health specifically disclaims responsibility for any analyses, interpretations or conclusions".

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COMMENTARY

POPULATION

Table 1 shows the population of Philadelphia as of the April 1, 2000 Census. The total of 1,517,550 represents a decline of 68,027 (4.3%) from the April 1, 1990 Census count of 1,585,577. The distribution by race in the 2000 count was 683,267 (45%) White, 655,824 (43%) Black, 67,654 (4%) Asian, 729 (under 1%) Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander, 4,073 (under 1%) American Indian or Alaska native, 72,429 (5%) Other, and 33,574 (2%) Multiracial. The 2000 Census was the first that gave a "Multiracial" option, so this precludes direct comparability to earlier race distribution counts.

A question on ethnicity showed that 128,928 people were Hispanic or Latino, representing 8% of the City's total population. They may be of any race category.

MORBIDITY (Disease)

Certain diseases and conditions must be reported to the Philadelphia Department of Public Health by anyone (generally a physician) who encounters a suspected case. Table 2 includes most diseases or conditions on the reportable disease list, even though certain diseases have not occurred in Philadelphia for some years. It is believed that some diseases are not fully reported to the Health Department, so some counts may be understated.

There were 8,170 reported cases of gonorrhea in 2000, up from 7,776 in 1999. The 2000 figure was well below the peak of 22,976 in 1988.

The number of <u>syphilis</u> cases in 2000 was 622. The number of cases in 1990 (6,558) was the highest since 1949. There were 67 cases of <u>primary and secondary syphilis</u> in 2000, well below the 2,361 cases in 1990. The number of primary and secondary syphilis cases began increasing in 1986 but has now declined for ten years in a row. There were 9 cases of <u>congenital syphilis</u> reported in 2000.

<u>Chlamydia</u> became reportable in late 1991. There were 13,593 cases reported in 2000, up from the 1999 count of 12,660 cases. This was numerically the largest of the reportable diseases.

There were no cases of measles reported in 2000, in contrast to the 1,391 cases reported during the measles outbreak of 1991.

MORBIDITY (Disease) (Cont.)

Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS) cases totaled 1,077 in 2000. Counts of AIDS are by year of case report, not year of diagnosis.

A total of 327 cases of <u>salmonellosis</u> were reported in 2000. There were 115 cases of <u>shigellosis</u> (bacillary dysentery) in 2000. There were 148 cases of <u>campylobacteriosis</u> in 2000, and a total of 132 cases of <u>giardiasis</u> were reported.

Most cases of lead toxicity are reported as the result of screening children ages one through five years in the Philadelphia Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program. There were 860 cases of all ages in 2000.

In 2000, a total of 390 cases of <u>viral hepatitis</u> were reported, a figure much lower than the 856 cases of 1990 and the 1,091 cases in 1989. Of the 390 cases, 255 were <u>Type A (infectious)</u>, 134 were <u>Type B (serum)</u>, and 1 was <u>Type C</u>. The large numbers in 1989 and 1990 were largely accounted for by Type A hepatitis.

There were 170 cases of <u>tuberculosis</u> reported in 2000. Of the 170 cases, 127 were <u>pulmonary</u> and 43 were <u>non-pulmonary</u>.

Lyme disease had 165 cases reported in 2000, down from the 220 cases in 1999.

The Division of Disease Control of the Philadelphia Department of Public Health publishes a yearly report called "Annual Surveillance Summary" with detail on most of the reportable diseases and conditions. The Report is available from that Division (phone # 215-685-6740).

MORTALITY (Deaths)

There were 17,618 deaths to residents of Philadelphia in 2000. Resident deaths include those events occurring in the City to Philadelphia residents, (15,262), plus those events occurring to Philadelphia residents in places outside the City limits (2,356). A total of 18,312 deaths occurred in Philadelphia, of which 15,262 were residents and 3,050 were to people who didn't live in Philadelphia.

Of the 17,618 resident deaths, a total of 10,071 were White, 7,325 were Black, 189 were Asian and the remainder was of other races or race was not stated. There were 561 deaths to persons of Hispanic Origin, although these persons can be of any race.

A copy of the Pennsylvania Certificate of Death is included in the Appendix. All death data comes from information contained on this certificate.

Infant Deaths

In 2000, there were 224 deaths to Philadelphia resident infants under one year of age. This was 28 deaths lower than the 1999 figure, and was the lowest total since resident statistics were collected beginning in 1954. The infant death rate of 10.3 was the lowest on record for Philadelphia. For comparison, the rate in 1980 was 18.1, in 1970 was 27.0, and in 1960 was 32.4.

By race, there were 53 White infant deaths, for a rate of 6.1. There were 159 Black infant deaths, for a rate of 14.1.

Infant deaths are subdivided into neonatal (deaths during the first 27 days of life) and post-neonatal (deaths to infants aged 28 through 364 days). Of the 224 total infant deaths, 144 were neonatal and 80 were post-neonatal.

MORTALITY (Deaths) (Cont'd.)

Deaths By Cause

A new revision of the International Classification of Diseases (ICD) was implemented beginning with 1999 deaths. This is an internationally used system for assigning the "underlying cause of death" which is defined as "the disease or injury which initiated the train of morbid events leading directly to death, or the circumstances of the accident or violence which produced the fatal injury". The cause of death shown in the Report are underlying causes.

The new revision of the ICD is the Tenth Revision, and is the first revision in twenty years. It uses a completely new coding scheme and, as a result, some major causes of death are not comparable to those of the Ninth Revision. Causes such as Diseases of Heart, Malignant Neoplasm, Cerebrovascular Diseases, Accidents, Diabetes Mellitus, Intentional Self Harm (Suicide), Chronic Liver Disease and Cirrhosis, Atherosclerosis and Assault (Homicide) are very comparable between the Ninth and Tenth Revisions. The most different is "Influenza and Pneumonia" which will only have about 70 percent as many deaths assigned to that cause in ICD-10 as in ICD-9. On the other hand, Alzheimer's Disease will have 55 percent more deaths assigned to it in ICD-10.

The Appendix to this Report contains the ICD-10 codes for the various causes of death shown in this Report.

As has been the case of many years, the three leading causes of death were diseases of the heart, malignant neoplasms (cancer), and cerebrovascular disease (stroke), with 4,893, 4,021, and 1,144 resident deaths respectively. Heart disease accounted for 27.8 percent of all resident deaths, malignant neoplasms 22.8 percent and cerebrovascular disease 6.5 percent, or 57.1 percent of all deaths for the leading three causes combined.

Tables 19-23 contain very detailed information on causes of death by age group, race and sex.

Chart B shows homicide deaths by cause from 1978 through 2000. Firearm deaths are clearly the major component of this category, and Table 24 A and B present detail on deaths from firearms. There were 250 firearm deaths out of 323 homicides in 2000, or 77.4 percent. The number of firearm homicide deaths in 1999 was 239.

NATALITY (Births)

There were 21,849 live births in 2000 to women who lived in Philadelphia, of which 18,952 occurred in Philadelphia and 2,897 occurred elsewhere. Additionally, 4,398 births occurred in Philadelphia to women who were not Philadelphia residents, of the 23,350 births which occurred in Philadelphia.

A copy of the Pennsylvania Certificate of Live Birth is included in the Appendix. All birth data comes from information contained on this certificate.

Race

Beginning with 1991, birth data was shown in this Report with an expanded race breakdown. Instead of the former breakdown of "White" and "All Others", there is now data available for White, Black and Asian. Table 25 shows that in 2000 there were 8,676 White, 11,255 Black, and 1,258 Asian births to Philadelphia resident women.

Beginning with 1990 data, Philadelphia began tabulating its birth data by race of the mother, in accordance with federal guidelines issued by the National Center for Health Statistics and implemented for 1989 and subsequent data years for federal and state reporting. The previous practice had been to determine the race of the child from the race of both parents, as reported on the birth certificate. The primary reason for the decision to tabulate births by race of mother was because of the new birth certificate, which was put into use for 1989 births. Many of the questions on the certificate are health questions directly associated with the mother (such as method of delivery, medical risk factors for the pregnancy, tobacco and alcohol use during pregnancy, maternal weight gain, complications of labor and/or delivery). Also relating to the mother are questions on her marital status, education level and receipt of prenatal care. It is more appropriate to use race of mother in tabulating these items. Additional factors in the decision to tabulate births by race of mother were the increasing percentage of births to parents not of the same race and the increasing percentage of births with race of father not stated on the certificate. However, the change did not significantly affect the tabulations by race for Philadelphia births.

Hispanic Origin

Beginning in 1991, birth data was shown in this report by Hispanic origin. Following the federal guidelines discussed in the preceding section, a child is of Hispanic origin if the mother answered affirmatively to the birth certificate question whether she was of Hispanic origin. In 2000, there were 2,565 births to Philadelphia resident women of Hispanic origin. Note that this is a separate question from race and therefore a person of Hispanic origin can be of any race.

NATALITY (Births) (Cont'd.)

Age of Mother

In 2000, there were 3,704 births to Philadelphia resident women under 20 years of age, representing 17.0 percent of all resident births. Of these, 119 (0.5%) were to mothers under age 15. The proportion of births to teenage mothers was 12.6 percent for White mothers, 21.0 percent for Black mothers, and 7.4 percent for Asian mothers. Of births to Hispanic women, 25.0 percent were to teenage mothers.

Prenatal Care

Table 41 shows that 70.4 percent of the women giving birth in 2000 had prenatal care beginning in the first trimester of pregnancy. By age only 58.9 percent of teenage mothers had first trimester prenatal care, compared to 70.9 percent of mothers in their 20's, and 76.0 percent of mothers age 30 or more.

By race, 78.6 percent of White mothers had prenatal care beginning in the first trimester, as did 64.6 percent of Black, and 66.9 percent of Asian mothers. For mothers of Hispanic origin, 69.9 percent began prenatal care in the first trimester.

Overall, 2.4 percent of all births were to mothers who had no prenatal care. By race, 1.4 percent of White mothers had no prenatal care, 3.5 percent of Black mothers and 1.0 percent of Asian mothers had no prenatal care. For mothers of Hispanic origin, 1.2 percent had no prenatal care.

The category "late or no prenatal care" is for births where the mother either did not begin prenatal care until the third trimester of pregnancy or had no prenatal care at all. In 2000, 6.3 percent of all births were in this category. By race, the proportion for White mothers was 4.0 percent, for Black mothers was 8.4 percent and for Asian mothers was 5.3 percent. For Hispanic mothers the proportion was 5.1 percent.

It should be noted however that the number of prenatal care visits, not only the trimester in which care began, is important. To reflect this concept, Table 43 shows births with "inadequate prenatal care". This includes not only births where prenatal care began in the third trimester or there was no prenatal care, but also includes those births where care began in the first or second trimester but

there were less than four total prenatal care visits. A total of 8.9 percent fit this definition in 2000. By race, 5.8 percent of births to White mothers, 11.6 percent to Black mothers and 7.3 percent to Asian mothers were defined as having "inadequate care". For Hispanic mothers, 7.7 percent of births fell in this category.

Birth Weight


Births of 5 pounds 8 ounces or less at birth are considered to be of low birth weight. Overall, 9.4 percent of 2000 births were in this category. By race, 7.9 percent of births to White mothers, 13.8 percent of births to Black mothers and 6.1 percent of births to Asian mothers were of low birth weight. 9.4 percent of births to Hispanic mothers were in this category.

Marital Status of Mother

In 2000, 61.3 percent of resident births were to women who answered in the negative to the question on the birth certificate "Is mother married to father?" By race 44.0 percent of births to White mothers, 78.5 percent to Black mothers, and 25.2 percent to Asian mothers were in this category, as were 73.8 percent of births to Hispanic mothers.

Medical Conditions

In 2000, 29.2 percent of births had medical risk factors indicated for the pregnancy 35.6 percent had complications of labor and/or delivery, 5.0 percent had abnormal conditions of the newborn, 1.1 percent had congenital anomalies and 21.5 percent of births were cesarean deliveries.





PHILADELPHIA: 1970 - 2000







APPENDIX

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PHILADELPHIA POPULATION AS OF APRIL 1, 1990 CENSUS

The April 1, 1990 Census showed a population of 1,585,577 for Philadelphia, a loss of 102,633 (6.1%) from 1980. Appendix Table 1 shows the 1990 City population by age, race and sex. The City of Philadelphia joined other cities and states in a court case challenging the accuracy of the 1990 Census, but the courts ordered no adjustment for undercount. As an example of undercount, the Census showed a population of 19,580 under 1 year of age; however, in 1990there were over 29,000 live births to Philadelphia resident women.

Race

In 1990, the Census showed that of the 1,585,577 people in Philadelphia, 848,586 or 53.5% classified themselves as White, 631,936 or 39.9% as Black, 43,522 or 2.7% as Asian and 61,533 or 3.9% classified themselves as other than these categories. For those 43,522 persons categorized as "Asian", 11,691 (26.9%) classified themselves as Chinese, 6,969 (16.0%) as Korean, 6,293 (14.5%) as Indian, 5,701 (13.1%) as Vietnamese, 4,026 (9.3%) as Cambodian, 3,993 (9.2%) as Filipino, and 1,319 (3.0%) as Japanese.

Hispanic Origin

It is important to note that race and Hispanic origin were separate questions on the Census questionnaire, and therefore Hispanics can be of any race. Of the 89,193 persons who answered affirmatively to the Census question whether they were "of Hispanic origin or descent". In general 22,747 (25.5%) checked their race as White, 8,426 (9.4%) as Black, 1,366 (1.5%) as Asian, 310 (0.3%) as American Indian, and 56,344 (63.2%) chose none of the specified race groups but instead checked "Other". Therefore, 56,344 (91.6%) of the 61,533 persons with race "Other" are Hispanic.

Age

In 1990, a total of 320,456 (20.2%) of Philadelphia's enumerated population was under 15 years of age. On the other hand 240,714 (15.2%) of the population was age 65 or over. The median age of the total population was 33.2 years.

Age and Race/Hispanic Origin

There are considerable differences among the different race groups regarding the age distribution of their population.

The proportion of the population under age 15 was 16.0% for White, 24.3% for Black, and 24.1% for Asian. The proportion was 31.8% for those of Hispanic origin, regardless of race. The proportion of the population age 65 or over was 19.6% for White, 11.1% for Black, and 5.1% for Asian. For those of Hispanic origin, the proportion was 4.6%. The median age of the White population was 36.5 years, of the Black population was 31.0 years, and of the Asians was 27.3 years. The median age of the Hispanic population was 24.2 years.

Sex

In 1990, 847,814 (53.5%) of the enumerated Philadelphia population were female. There were 110, 051 more females than males in the Census count.
