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Introduction

The Vital Statistics Report is issued annually by the Philadelphia Department of Public Health (PDPH). This report represents vital events that occurred in 2012. In accordance with the Philadelphia Home Rule Charter, the Department of Public Health is the City agency responsible for compiling, analyzing, maintaining, and reporting statistics concerning births, still-births, and deaths (Chapter 3, 5-300, d). The annual vital statistics report fulfills this function by detailing the vital events occurring to Philadelphia residents in a particular year.

Major findings of the 2012 Vital Statistics Report can be found in the natality and mortality summaries on pages 24 and 58. Results have been shown for all residents and by the 18 planning districts defined by the City of Philadelphia Planning Commission (<http://phila2035.org/home-page/district/>).

Beginning with the 2008 Vital Statistics report, PDPH began to provide findings for the entire population and by the race/ethnicity groups of non-Hispanic white, non-Hispanic black, non-Hispanic Asian, and Hispanic, based on the 31 race and ethnicity categories made available in the 2000 decennial census. Reporting by race and by ethnicity separately was dropped.

Beginning in 2005, the annual Vital Statistics report no longer included disease morbidity reporting. Morbidity reports for infectious, chronic, and environmental conditions can be found at <http://www.phila.gov/health/Commissioner/Reports.html>.

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Population Findings

Population Summary

This section contains population analyses for 2000 through 2012. Multiple population estimates were used depending on the analysis, including the Census Bureau's population count conducted every 10 years (decennial enumeration) and its annual population estimates for July of each year. Details can be found in the Technical Appendix.

The 2012 population of Philadelphia was estimated as 1,548,647 (Table P1). This represents a 1.5% increase from the 2010 enumerated population and a 2% increase from the 2000 enumerated population. From 1960 to 2010, the population of Philadelphia decreased by 24% from approximately 2 million to 1.5 million.

In 2012 (Table P2), there were 648,050 black non-Hispanics in Philadelphia, making up 42% of the total population. For white non-Hispanics, Hispanics, and Asian non-Hispanics, the values were 565,136 (36%), 201,800 (13%) and 102,635 (7%), respectively. People between the ages of 20 and 34 represented a larger proportion of the population among white non-Hispanics and Asian non-Hispanics than among black non-Hispanics and Hispanics (Figure P4). Among 0-4 year-olds, 22% are Hispanic and 46% are non-Hispanic black (Table P2).

Between 2000 and 2012, population growth was seen in the group 45-64 years of age, while declines were seen in the groups 5-14 and 65 and older (Figure P5A). In terms of changes by race/ethnicity, the fastest growing groups were Hispanics and non-Hispanic Asians, who increased by 72,000 and 33,000, respectively, between 2000 and 2012 (Figure P5B). White non-Hispanics decreased by 81,000. The non-Hispanic black group has remained virtually unchanged.

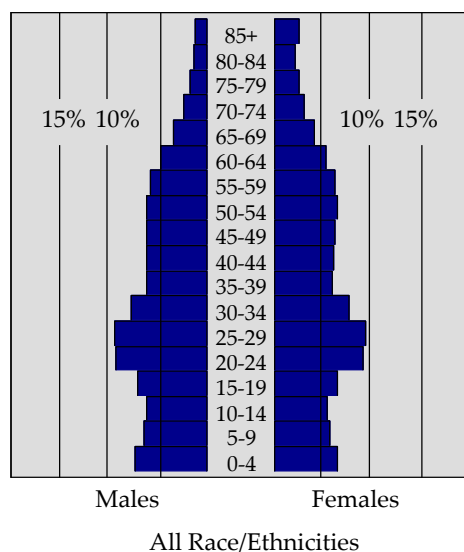
Analyses of population by planning districts (Table P3, Maps P1 and P2) demonstrate significant clustering by race-ethnicity. Non-Hispanic whites comprise large portions of the population in Northeast and South Philadelphia. Non-Hispanic blacks comprise large portions in West and North Philadelphia; Hispanics in North and Lower Northeast Philadelphia. Asians are most prevalent in South, Central, and Lower Northeast Philadelphia.

Yearly Estimated Population: Philadelphia, 2000 - 2012

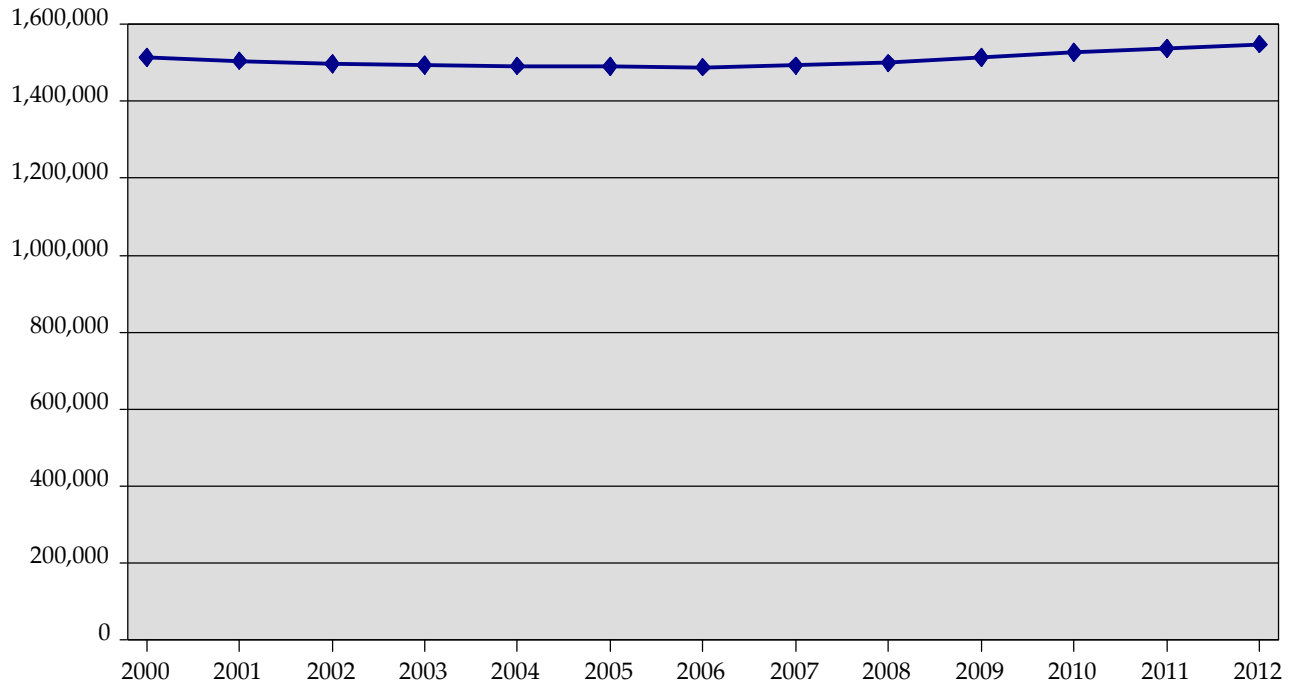
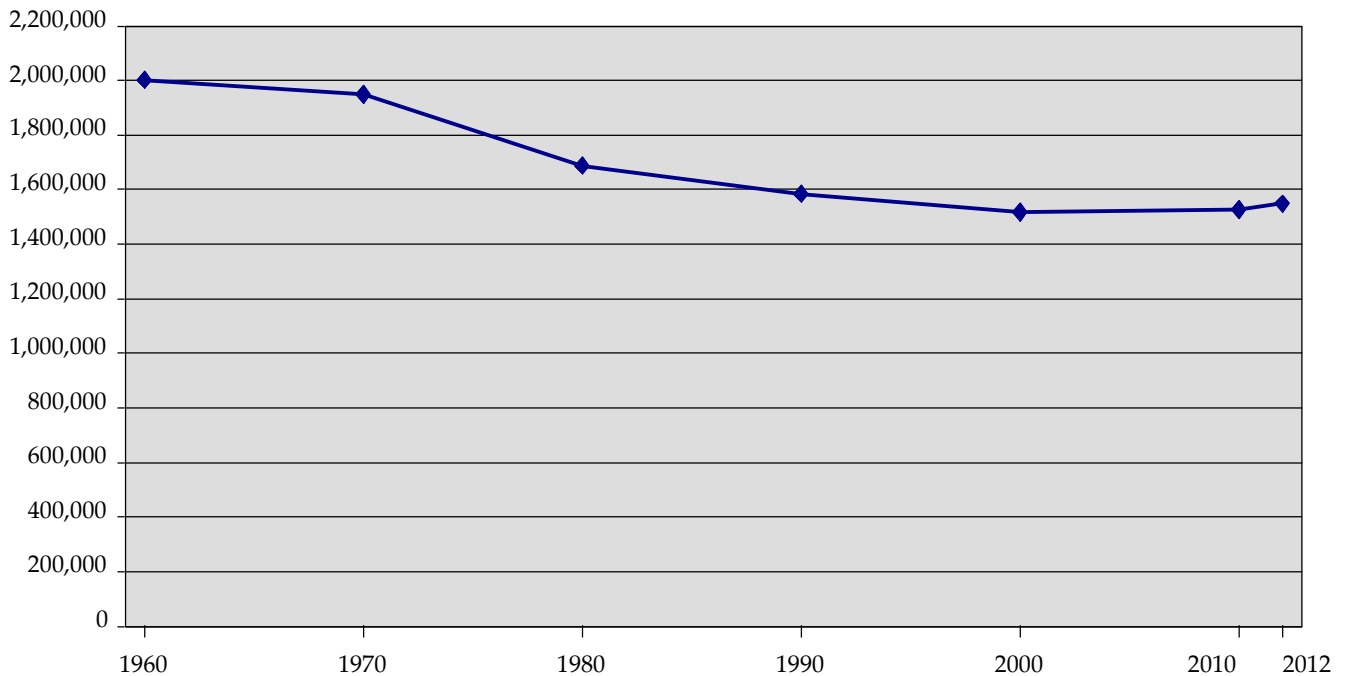

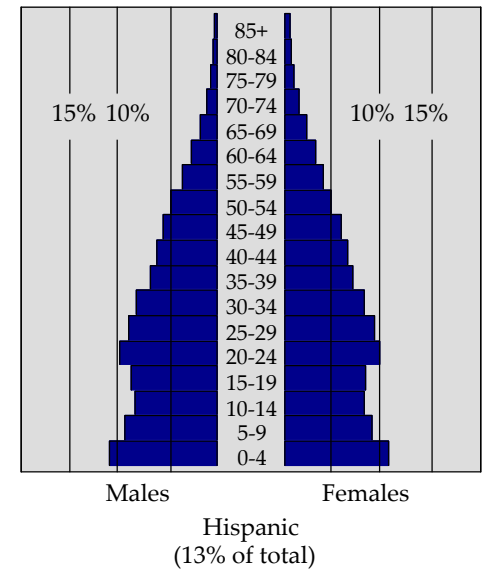
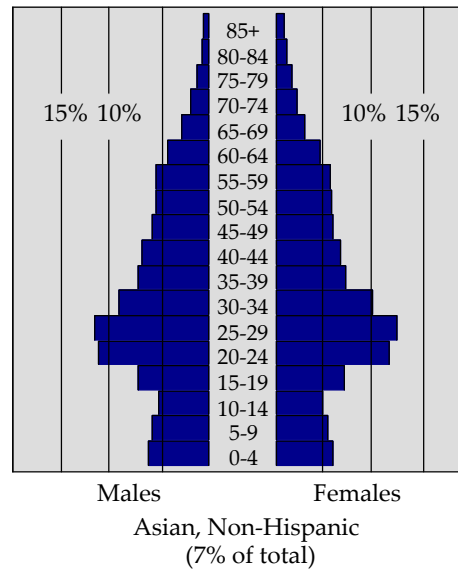
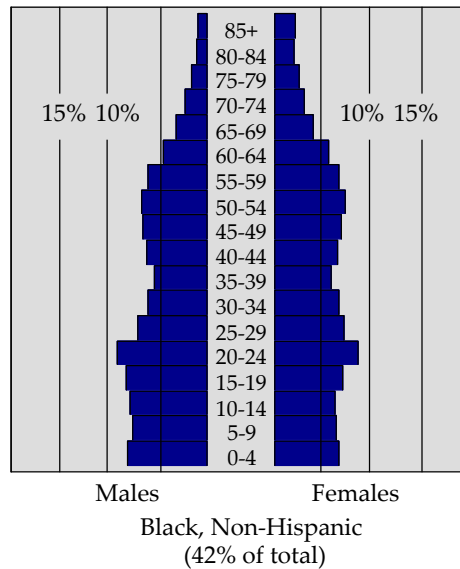
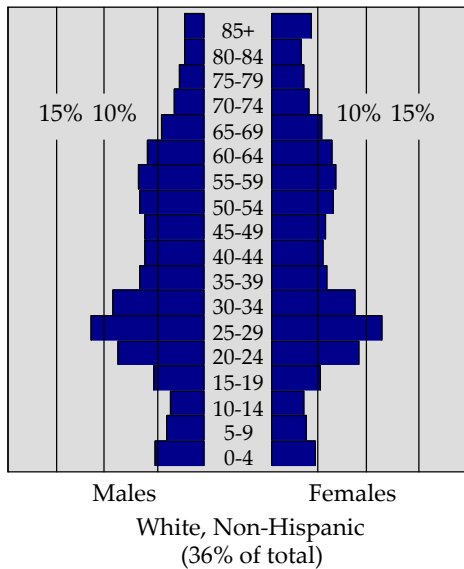
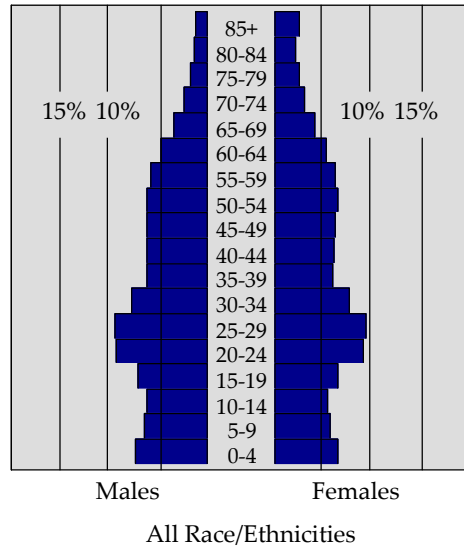

Yearly Estimated Population by Age Group: Philadelphia, 2000 - 2012

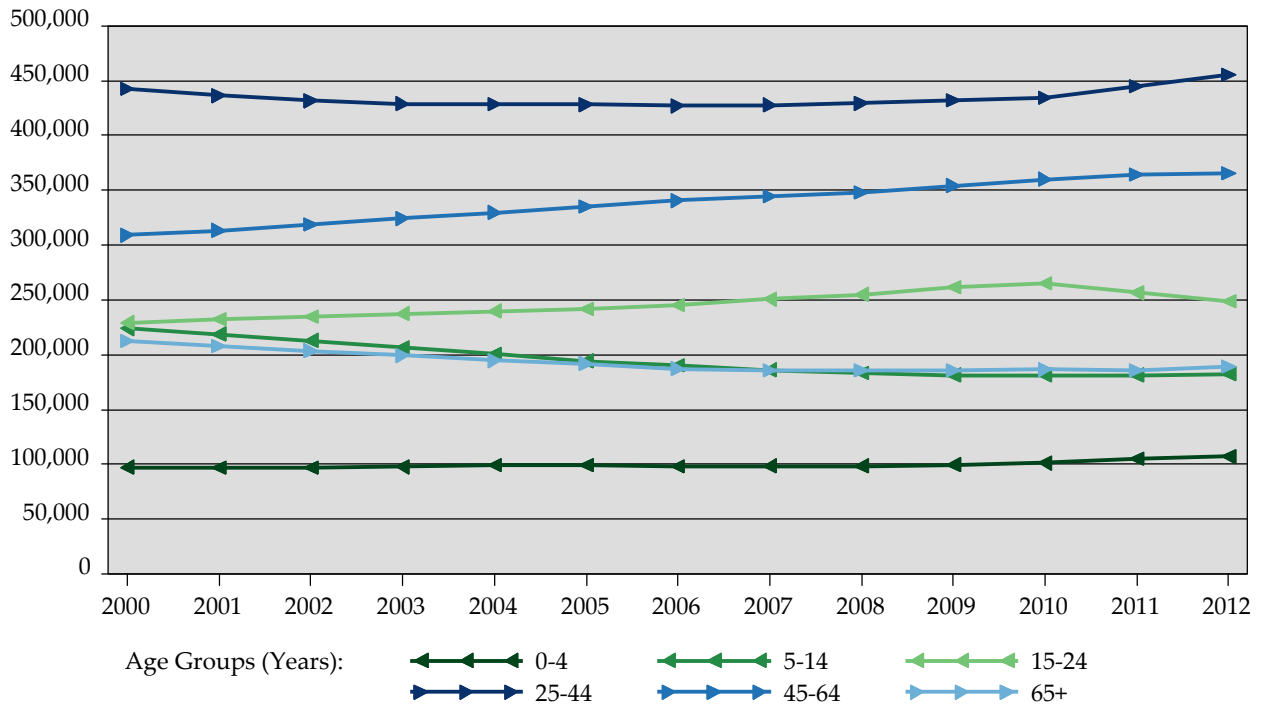
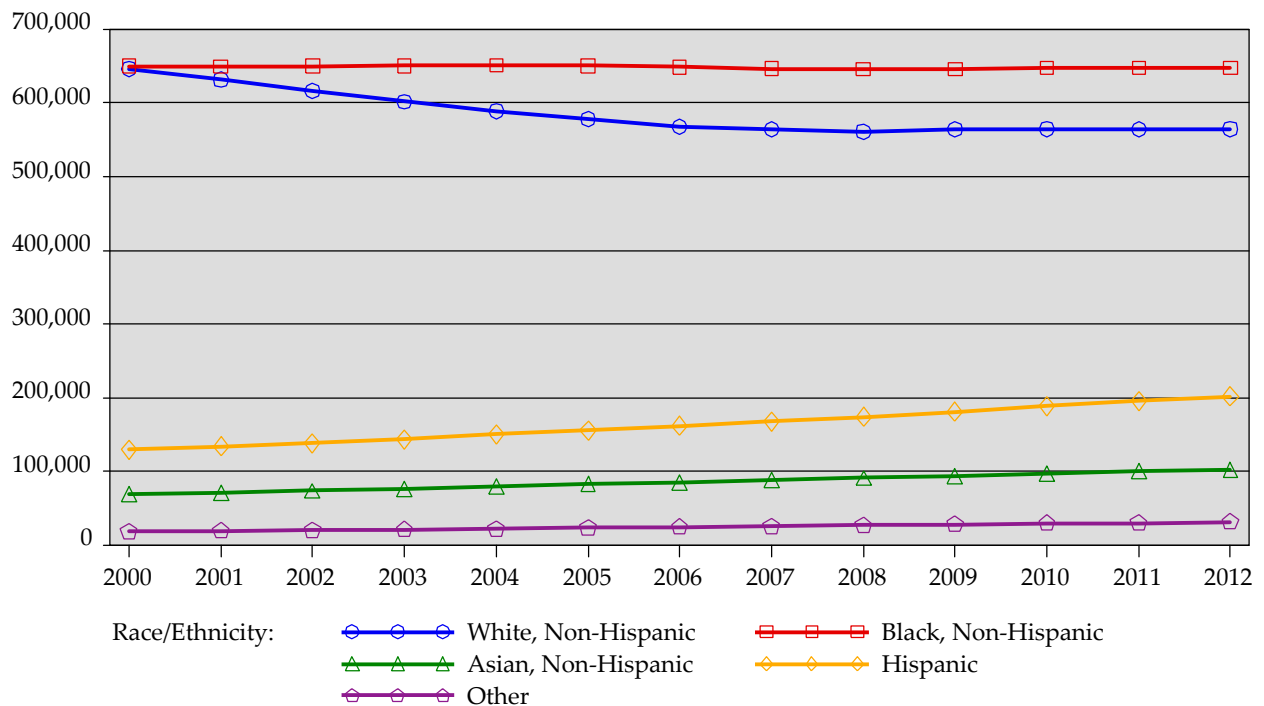

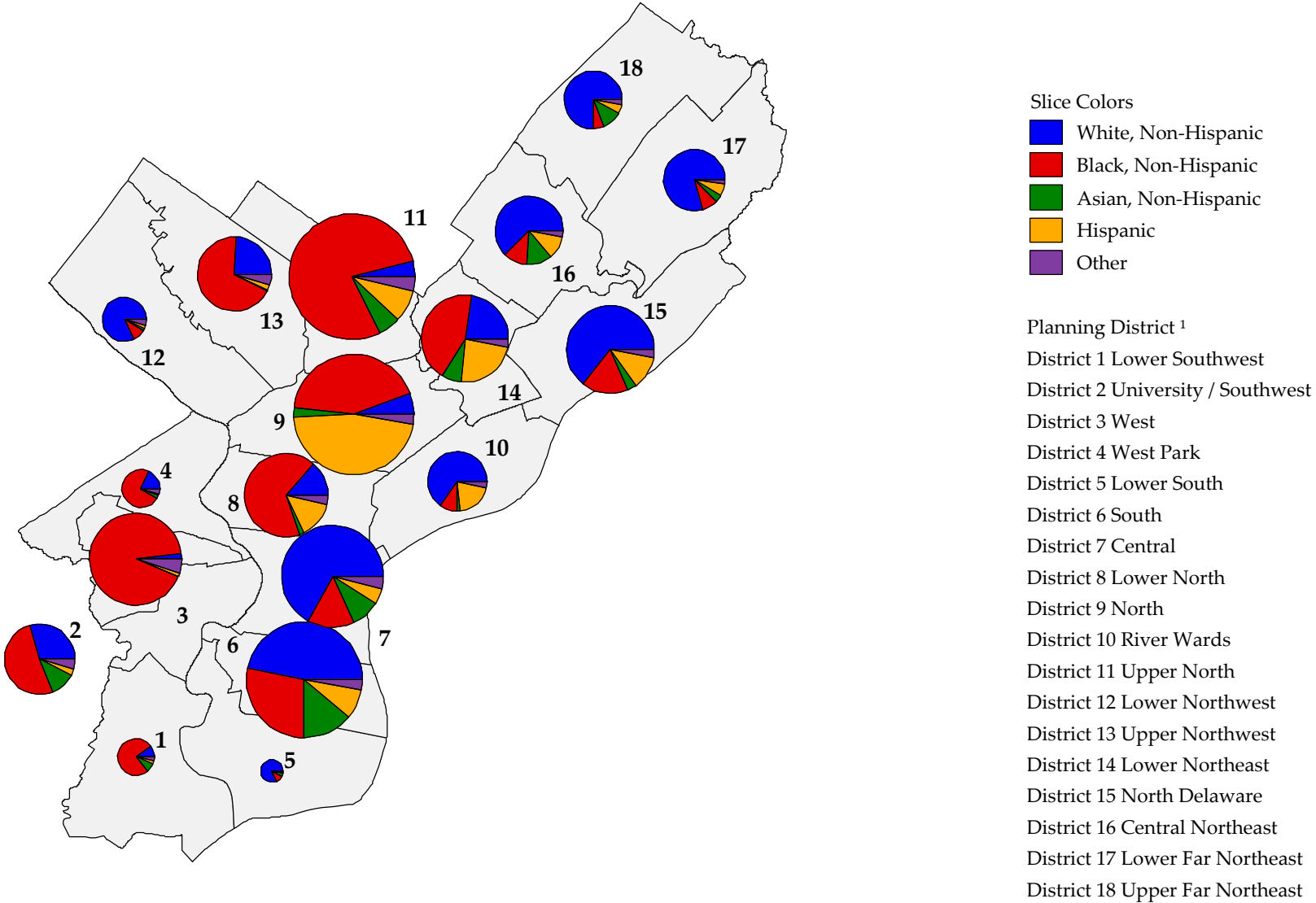
