- A. Who Must File: In order to obtain the tax credit authorized under the Contribution

 To A Qualifying Community Development Corporation or a Qualifying Nonprofit Intermediary, business firms must submit this renewal application for approval.
- B. When to File: Renewal Application must be filed on or before October 15th of each year with the City of Philadelphia, Department of Revenue.
- C. Signature and Mailing: The application must be signed by an authorized officer of the applicant. The original and two (2) copies of the renewal application (three (3) copies if co-sponsors) must be mailed to:

D. Claiming Tax Credit: Please submit your completed BIRT return with the Schedule SC and NPT return (if applicable) to the address listed in 'C'. Attach a copy (front & back) of the cancelled check remitted to the QCDC/ QNPI in the year you are claiming your credit.
