
The PES Refining Complex

- Oldest, largest refinery on the East Coast
- 1,400-acre facility comprised of: Girard Point Refinery Point Breeze Refinery Schuylkill River Tank Farm North Yard Rail & Storage

 Estimated economic impact associated with an illustrative year of operations at the Refining Complex at its pre-fire, pre-bankruptcy steady state

Steady State Operations



Estimated Annual Operating Expenditures

Based on currently available data:

Model Inputs (Direct)

- Annual Average Full-Time Employees: 1,950
- Total Annual Employee Compensation: \$237 M
- Total Annual Expenditures: \$1.1 B

Estimated Annual Economic Impact

City of Philadelphia

- Total Economic Impact: \$2.1 billion
- Jobs Supported (FTE): 6,300
- Total Employee Compensation: \$600 million

Estimated Annual Economic Impact

Philadelphia MSA


- Total Economic Impact: **\$2.3 billion**
- Jobs Supported (FTE): 7,600
- Total Employee Compensation: \$650 million

Estimated Annual Economic Impact

Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

- Total Economic Impact: \$2.3 billion
- Jobs Supported (FTE): 7,650
- Total Employee Compensation: \$640 million

Estimated Employment Impact



Tax Impact Methodology

- Not based on actual direct tax data
- Not based on IMPLAN estimates
- Customized tax model based on Philadelphia and Pennsylvania effective rates

Estimated Annual Tax Impact

City of Philadelphia

Total Estimated Tax Impact*: \$33.2 million

* Includes Income, Business, Sales & Use, Property, and Use & Occupancy Taxes

Estimated Annual Tax Impact

Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

Total Estimated Tax Impact*: \$30 million
