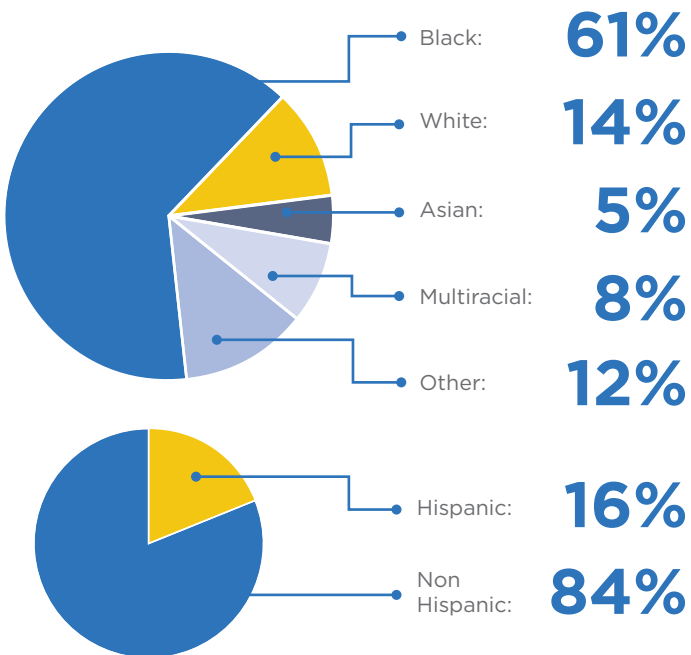

**39** Providers improved their quality rating from STAR 1 or 2 to STAR 3 or 4 since joining PHLpreK<sup>4</sup>

Moving **898** PHLpreK slots, and over **1,208** other slots to quality<sup>5</sup>

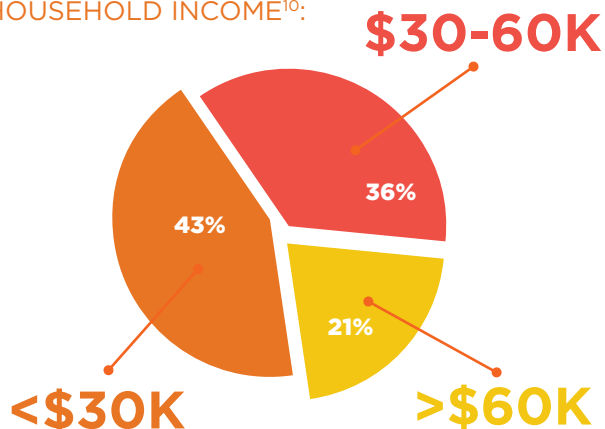
