Keep your non-essential business safe while it's closed. Business owners can help protect their property by following these tips.

1. Check your property often. If you see any damage, call 911.
2. Keep your storefront clean so it's clear you're keeping an eye on your business.
3. Make sure your storefront reflects the name and address of your business in case law enforcement is needed.
4. Secure dumpsters, trash cans, etc., to prevent people from accessing your building through the roof or windows.
5. Keep your property well lit.
6. Make sure your security camera is working properly.
7. Reinforce windows and doors to prevent breakage and cover with paper so no one can see inside.
8. Empty display cases and shelves of goods.
9. Leave cash registers open and empty at night.
10. Remove or lock up items of value, including money and equipment.
11. Install alarms if you do not have them.
