Conditions & Penalties	6	 A. Outdoor Dining may only operate between 8 a.m. and 12 a.m. the following day. Last call for all dining orders will be at 11 p.m. and establishments will be required to be closed for service by midnight. All patrons must be vacated by no later than 12:30 a.m. B. Seating capacity of interior and exterior dining combined may not exceed the capacity of the existing business. C. Access to bathrooms and hand washing facilities must be provided. D. No food preparation, plastic food displays, food storage, or refrigeration apparatus shall be permitted in the public right-of-way. E. Each café is permitted to have one portable sign (max. 10 sq. ft. in area and max. 5 ft. in height). F. Umbrellas shall be of fire-retardant material and canopy shall be a max of 6 feet in diameter and set up a min of 80" above grade. G. Moveable furniture (tables, chairs, etc.) must be moved inside building or secured to ground when not in use H. Moveable furniture must be labeled as property of business I. Space heaters shall be permitted if they are approved for outdoor use, installed in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations, and located at least two (2) feet from the edge of any umbrella canvas, any foliage, or any other flammable object or material. J. The City may require the removal of the sidewalk café or Streetery when necessary for redevelopment of the street/sidewalk, for utility repairs, or to restore pedestrian or traffic flow. K. Outdoor dining operations and patron behavior that fail to comply with the above conditions, threaten public health or safety, or create a private or public nuisance may result in fines of up to \$2000 per offense, ceasing of outdoor dining, and/or legal action to revoke or suspend the restaurant food license.
