
#### **Project Overview**

Formed in 2017, the Broad, Germantown, and Erie (BGE) Task Force is a joint effort between City departments & neighborhood organizations. **The goals are to:** 

- Make the intersection safer for pedestrians
- Create jobs and support businesses
- Improve and create new public spaces
- Honor local history and culture









# Public Participation Process









#### **Co-Designing Outreach Plan**

**Ongoing** meetings with stakeholders from May 2020 – present

Language Access survey and outreach materials were in English, Spanish, alt-text Bilingual staff at some in-person survey days







#### Survey

From September 22, 2020 through October 20, 2020, the BGE Task Force asked for feedback in an online survey asking residents, neighborhood stakeholders, and SEPTA riders to the two triangles, streets, & sidewalks.





- 2 days of in-person surveying
- 2 locations: Broad & Erie and food distribution at the Lenfest Center
- 2 days of in-person outreach to businesses
- 6 neighborhood meetings attended, reaching
- 75 meeting attendees (estimated)








#### **Responses by Geography**




## **Nearby Zip Code Map**






#### **Design Inspiration**






#### **Plaza Layouts**





#### Parking or more space for trees?

Near Max's on Germantown Ave (existing location)






#### **Route 23 Bus Stop Location**




#### **Special Features**

#### **KEY FINDINGS:**

**Lawn** is the clear favorite special feature option

Both the Stage and trolley car kiosk were ranked equally as least favorite

**Grouping of Trees** 






#### **Shade Preference**






## **Lighting Options**


## **Seating Options**

#### **KEY FINDINGS:**

Fixed Tables and Chairs were the favorite

Bistro and high-top tables and chairs were equally ranked as least favorite.

These results were the same for all responses and responses from nearby zip codes.

Movable seats on tracks






## **Other Seating Elements**

#### **KEY FINDINGS:**

Majority would like to have sculptural seating, among all survey respondents and nearby zipcodes.

Slim majority of all survey takers would like to have movable seats on tracks.

For nearby zip codes, slim majority would **not** like to have **movable seats on tracks**.




#### **Color Palette**

#### **KEY FINDINGS:**

Strong preference for **bright** colors

Same among all respondents and nearby zip code responses






## **Using the Space**

#### **KEY FINDINGS:**

- Most uses are well liked
- Less "yes" for playing with children & book reading, could be because not everyone has kids
- Did not ask people if they have kids
- Performances not as popular as passive activities
- Preferences the same for all respondents and nearby Zip codes

- Never






## **Closing Germantown Ave**

#### **KEY FINDINGS:**

- One day a month and one day every few months are the most popular
- Nearby zip code responses:
   Slightly more "never" answers,
   most would like to see it closed
   at least one day a month.






#### **Activities if Germantown Avenue is closed**

#### **KEY FINDINGS:**

- All options were popular
- Preferences the same for all respondents and nearby zip codes







#### **General Support**

- 62 comments advocating for different options in the survey
- 42 comments of overall support
- 10 comments advocating for trees specifically
- 4 comments on having intergenerational space
- 4 comments saying "do it already!"
- 2 comments complimenting process

"I lived around this area for over 50. I am excited to see N.Philly being recognized. I know whatever design is chosen it will be a joy for everyone."

"I can't wait for this project to finally break ground!"



**Concerns or Issues Raised** 

- 130 comments about maintenance and security
- 14 comments about traffic calming
- 10 comments about **gentrification**
- 5 comments about ADA accessibility
   & senior-friendly design
- 4 comments about noise
- No direct concerns about process

"A high level of safety to the area so that the community can have a wonderful experience!!"

"Trash clean up and regular maintenance! You can make a beautiful design but if it is not maintained, it doesn't matter."

"Protect people in the public space from distracted drivers."

"It is my hope that this space is inclusive and respects those in the community without gentrifying the area. Please give us the opportunity and resources we rightfully deserve in our communities without pushing us out!"





#### **Additional Ideas and Thoughts**

- 8 requests for incorporation of local art or murals
- 6 requests for WIFI and/or charging stations
- 4 requests for a community information board/local art display
- 6 requests for bright lighting
- 4 requests for lighting to be soft/gentle/down-lit/up-lit
- 3 requests for a "Welcome to Broad & Erie" sign

# Next Steps







#### **Summary & Take Away**

6 meetings with 5 RCOs & Civic Associations767 survey responses across 2 languages1600 flyers distributed with phone, text, and online feedback options

#### What we heard:

- Preference for **literature** for the theme and **circles** for the layout
- Lawn, fixed seating, and string lights were preferred features
- Preference for bright colors and a combination of shade structure and trees
- More space for trees preferred by all survey takers, more space for parking slightly more preferred by survey takers in nearby zip codes.
- Close Germantown Ave. between Broad & Erie once a month or once every few months.
- Maintenance and security are crucial





#### Follow-Up

- Revise the design of the triangles based on feedback from the survey
- Share the new proposed design with the community for final revisions
- Implement temporary improvements in 2021 and facilitate further engagement and testing of features
- Construct the project in 2022 through 2023
