


WHAT IS PARTICIPATORY BUDGETING?

Participatory Budgeting (PB) in the City of Philadelphia is a democratic process in which community members will generate ideas and vote directly on how to spend \$1 million dollars on capital projects. **It gives the public real power over real money.**

HOW IT WORKS

The City has launched a six month cycle of engagement that is combined with the regular budgeting process. The PB process follows these steps:
