


# **CENSUS BUREAU OPERATIONS UPDATE:**

On April 13, the U.S. Census Bureau released a <u>press release</u>, indicating the below changes to their operations, as well as the request for statutory relief from Congress for an 120 additional days to deliver the final apportionment counts.

- Field office operations delayed until June 1
- Data collection operations extended to **October 31**
- Apportionment numbers due to Administration April 30, 2021 (\*awaiting statutory relief from Congress)
- Redistricting numbers due to state July 31, 2021 (\*awaiting statutory relief from Congress)

# **COLLEGES & UNIVERSITIES:**



College students: Students should still be counted where they live at school, even though they may have gone home for the remainder of the semester. This was already a focus of our training, but now that students have left campuses we need to refocus on this outreach effort. We are encouraging professors to take the first 5 minutes of their lecture to show this slide and encourage students to participate. Colleges and Universities: view our higher ed toolkit here.
