I have read the Notice in the recent water bill and understand that the Philadelphia Water Department is proposing rate increases of 11.6% and 7.2% for residential and small business accounts, respectively to take effect in September, 2021. In addition, there are proposed rate increases of 5.3% and 5.7% for ONLY a year later for residential and small business accounts. These are cumulative rate increases of 16.9% and 12.9%, respectively in a two year period! I OPPOSE THE RATE INCREASES.


